SARATOGA While Holy Bull (Great Above) enjoyed an afternoon stroll around the Monmouth Park oval, winning yesterday's GI \$500,000 Haskell Invitational by a deceivingly easy length and a quarter and setting himself up as the prohibitive favorite for the GI Travers August 20, Preakness and Belmont S. winner **Tabasco Cat** (Storm Cat) found his way to the Saratoga winner's circle blocked Sunday afternoon. The 2-5 favorite in the GI Jim Dandy made a run at second choice **Unaccounted For** (Private Account), who was making his stakes debut, but came up a length short. "He wasn't tight enough today," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "You're always disappointed when you lose, but not from where we came and what we want to do. I thought he ran very solid off the long layoff. You've got to remember, he's just off the farm. Our goal is to be ready August 20. I expected him to win, but I'm not totally disappointed. I felt he got a little tired at the end. That wasn't chopped liver out there that beat us, either." Winning trainer Scotty Schulhofer will send **Unaccounted For** against both the Cat and the Bull in the Midsummer Derby. "The thing I liked about his performance was that he fought hard with **Tabasco Cat** coming down the stretch," said Schulhofer. "He didn't want to give up, and that really pleased me." It is possible that someone may add a rabbit to the Travers menagerie, but Holy Bull's pilot, Mike Smith, is not worried. "If someone is crazy enough to come after him, that's okay," he commented. "They can go out there in :21 and we'll just sit a couple lengths off them. I don't think it would be a problem. He's out there on the lead because he is naturally so fast--he can run horses into the ground. But there's no reason he can't sit off it. He's a classy individual; he would overcome it."

BREATHING PROBLEM STOPS SEA HERO IN SWORD DANCER Trainer MacK. Miller reported Sunday morning that **Sea Hero** (Polish Navy) experienced a breathing problem on his way to a disappointing seventh-place finish in Saturday's **Sword Dancer** H. Following the race, Miller had the '93 Kentucky Derby winner scoped but found no trace of blood; he now believes **Sea Hero** may have suffered a displaced soft palate. "He had never done this before," said the Hall of Fame trainer. "It was terribly disappointing. We were baffled, because he had acted so good in the paddock. Jerry (Bailey) said that he was running so well but then just collapsed." Miller does not feel this will be a long-term problem, but said he has no immediate plans for the colt's next start.

MATCH RACE SET FOR DEL MAR For the first time since the great **Seabiscuit** beat **Ligaroti** by a desperate nose in 1938, **Del Mar** will be the site of a match race, set for August 21. **Soviet Problem** (Moscow Ballet), winner of 11 of 14 lifetime and victorious over colts in the **Valkyr H.** at **Hollywood** last out, will face **Cool Air** (Air Forbes Won), who also defeated colts in her latest, taking the **Hollywood Budweiser Breeders' Cup H.** July 15 for a record of 12 wins from 26 career starts. The two four-year-olds will go five furlongs on the grass, the first time a race has been run at that distance on turf at **Del Mar**. Both runners will carry 116 pounds; the purse, approximately \$100,000, will be divided with 80 percent to the winner and 20 percent to the loser. The race will be held in the middle of the day's card, and exacta betting will be available.
