TOP THREE-YEAR-OLDS SET FOR TRAVERS

Owner/trainer Jimmy Croll reported yesterday morning that Sunday's GI Haskell winner **Holy Bull** (Great Above) came out of the race in good shape and will now point for the \$750,000 Travers at Saratoga August 20. "Everything's great," said Croll. "He seems to have come out of the race fine so far." About the impending match with **Tabasco Cat** (Storm Cat), second in Sunday's GI Jim Dandy at Saratoga, Croll remarked, "I saw the Jim Dandy. Very frankly, I was a little disappointed. I had hoped Tabasco would win. It would have made good talk." As for travel plans, the veteran horseman said, "It's very likely he'll ship the day before. I'm a late shipper; I do that a lot. I've always had good luck doing that." Trainer D. Wayne Lukas said Monday that Tabasco Cat is also on track for the Travers. "He's fine. He's no worse for the wear, and he should move forward after this effort." Lukas added that the loss Sunday should not compromise his colt's chances for year-end honors. "I learned long ago in basketball, if you have a 25-game schedule, you circle six or seven games that you can't afford to lose if you wanted to be champion," he said. "I think we could lose that game (Jim Dandy) without hurting our chances at a championship season as long as we win our key games." Lukas added that while he has a possible "rabbit" in his barn, it is unlikely he will run an entry in the Travers. "If we do that and beat him, all of you guys will say it's because we double teamed him." Jim Dandy winner **Unaccounted For** (Private Account) will also make his next start in the Midsummer Derby. "I think he's got a chance," said trainer Scotty Schulhofer. "He's proved he's got enough class."

SARATOGA CUP H., \$250,000, 3yo/up, 9f
The Saratoga Cup is expected to draw six GI winners. Trainer Scotty Schulhofer will saddle **Colonial Affair** (Pleasant Colony), hero of last year's Belmont S. The four-year-old worked five furlongs at Saratoga Sun. in 1:01.26. "I'm expecting to win," said Schulhofer, "or else I wouldn't enter the race." **Miner's Mark** (Mr. Prospector) is looking for his first win since last year's GI Jockey Club Gold Cup; the colt won the Jim Dandy at Saratoga last year. The '92 Travers winner **Thunder Rumble** (Thunder Puddles), who earned his first victory since that GI performance in a seven-furlong allowance at Belmont July 20, will also point for the race. "We're happy with the way he's readjusted to Saratoga," said his trainer, Richie O'Connell. "He'll work either Wed. or Thurs." **Wallenda** (Gulch) worked for the race Mon., going five-eighths in 1:01.70 over Saratoga's main track, while **West by West** (Gone West) went the same distance in 1:03.45 over the Oklahoma training track. Rounding out the GI half dozen is **Pistols and Roses** (Darn That Alarm).

Two-time Ramona winner **Flawlessly** (Affirmed) is set to try for her third; she will take on '93 champion **Hollywood Wildcat** (Kris S.), who finished just in front of her when second in the GI Beverly Hills H. last time out. EPSOM DERBY GETS NEW DATE Epsom's Derby is now virtually certain to abandon its traditional spot on the first Wednesday in June in favor of a more lucrative weekend position. Following extensive talks with local pressure groups, including businesses concerned over the effect on trade, the 1995 renewal of the classic appears set to be run Saturday, June 10. David Hillyard, director of Racecourse Holdings Trust which runs the track, said, "The local community is keen on a Friday-Saturday-Sunday fixture." A sponsor is now all that is needed to complete plans for the switch, since Ever Ready's support finished with this season's race. But a group of potential backers are already having talks with RHT and Hillyard added, "We're looking for a deal which covers at least three years and if we haven't secured one by early autumn we may have to run the 1995 Derby without a sponsor. But I'm not unduly worried about that prospect. The most important thing is to get the right sponsor."
