Jockey Chris McCarron, who picked up the mount on the six-year-old because regular pilot Kent Desormeaux has a commitment to ride Lakeway in the Alabama at Saratoga the same day, was aboard for the move.

California horsemen will be able to bid on the sale through Fasig-Tipton representative Tom Sayre in the Del Mar Satellite Wagering facility.

**FOXFIELD TO SELL 55 HEAD AT FASIG-TIPTON NOVEMBER SALE** Carl Icahn's Foxfield will sell a portion of its large broodmare band, along with the mares' foals, at Fasig-Tipton's November sale. Approximately 30 mares and 25 foals will be auctioned Sunday night, November 6. According to Rob Whiteley, Foxfield's director of operations, "The foals are a good group, and we intend to sell the foals in front of the mares so that buyers can get a good look at what the mares can do. We have supported our stallions with good mares to help them get started in the right way, and now that they are established and doing well, we are going to scale back our broodmare band accordingly."
