TODAY'S NATIONAL BEST SEVEN LINE-UP

The seven races which make up this week's National Best Seven are the \$250,000 Saratoga Cup (Saratoga), Gill \$200,000 Sorority S. (Monmouth), Gill Omaha Gold Cup (AKsarben), \$50,000 Big John A. S. (Del Mar), \$150,000 Arlington Budweiser Breeders' Cup (Arlington), \$75,000 Dr. Fager division of the Florida Stallion S. (Calder) and \$50,000 HBP A H. (Ellis Park). The Jackpot carryover, to be paid out in the event of a single winning ticket, is now \$177,140.

MATCHMAKER S. RUNNERS CHOOSE

THEIR PARTNERS The owners of the first three finishers of last Saturday's Gil Matchmaker S. at Atlantic City have made their selections for the stallion services offered as bonuses in the race. George Strawbridge Jr., who campaigns Matchmaker winner **Alice Springs** (Val de l'Orne), has chosen the service of **Black Tie Affair** (Miswaki); the 1991 Horse of the Year stands at the Vinery in Kentucky and his first foals arrived this year. Frank Stronach, owner of runner-up **Hero's Love** (Hero's Honor), has opted for 1991 Kentucky Derby winner **Strike the Gold** (Alydar), who also stands at Vinery and whose first crop hits the ground next year. Darley Stud Management, Inc., owners of the Matchmaker third-place finisher **Cox Orange** (Tremolino), will receive a season to 1992 Derby winner **Lil E. Tee** (At the Threshold), who entered stud this year. Matchmaker owners may opt to send the mare who competed in the race or an approved substitute to accept the service.

NEAR-RECORD NUMBER CATALOGUED FOR KEENELAND SEPTEMBER SALE

A near-record 3,492 horses will be catalogued for Keeneland's September Yearling Sale, to be held September 12-21; the sale was originally scheduled to end September 20, but was extended one day to accommodate the large number of horses entered. The record of 3,558 was catalogued for the 1990 sale. Sessions for this year's 10-day auction begin daily at 10:00 a.m. Records for gross and average were established at last year's sale, when receipts totaled \$87,710,100 for 2,494 hips, an average of \$35,168.

Never beaten on the Del Mar turf, **Flawlessly** (Affirmed) looks to repeat her success in last year's Ramona, when she carried 125 pounds to a one-length victory. It was her second win in this event. Third in her most recent try, the veteran racemare missed winning the GI Beverly Hills H. by just a neck after finding herself in tight along the rail for half the stretch. Favored at even-money in that race, **Hollywood Wildcat** (Kris S.) closed well to be second, a nose in front of her older rival. Nine juvenile fillies go postward; trainer D. Wayne Lukas, who has saddled two winners of the event, will send out **Cat Appeal** (Storm Cat). The Overbrook Farm filly was a convincing winner of her only previous start, breaking her maiden by 9 1/4 at Saratoga July 23. "At this time of year, when two-year-olds break their maidens impressively, they're likely of some quality," said Lukas. Also shipping down from New York is Scotty Schulhofer charge **Stormy Blues** (Cure the Blues), a 16-length maiden winner in impressive time at Belmont July 1; Julie Krone rides. The local favorite will be **The Administrator** (Afleet), who broke her maiden at first asking at Monmouth, then came back to finish second in the Colleen S. "The field comes up a lot tougher than the Colleen did," said her conditioner, Robert Scanlon. "We can get a pretty good line on what kind of filly she is (today), that's for sure."

Ten Canadian-bred two-year-olds look for their first stakes success. **Try and Be Clever** (Regal Intention), a May foal, makes his stakes debut after breaking his maiden in his second start at Woodbine July 24. He faces **Saints Leader** (Silver Deputy), winner by 2 3/4 in his lone start July 17 at six furlongs, and **Native Regent** (Vice Regent), who is winless in three starts but was second in the Clarendon S. and third in the Colin S., both at Woodbine, in his three career tries.

The Oklahoma-bred gelding rebounded from an eighth-place finish in the GI Preakness to take the Texas Heritage S. at Sam Houston by 8 1/4, and the Colorado Derby by 17 1/2. His seven rivals include **Finder's Wish** (Derby Wish), a 2xSW with four wins in seven starts this year; and California shipper **Almaraz** (Alysheba), winless in 10 prior '94 outings but third in the Bradbury S. at Santa Anita earlier in his campaign.

Nine distaff turf specialists vie for the winner's share of the pot; the highweight is six-year-old **One Dreamer** (Relaunch) at 117. Two-for-four in '94, the 5xSW earned her first graded event at Churchill Downs in May, taking the Gill Louisville Breeders' Cup by four lengths. Last out, she was a popular winner of the Office Wife S. at Arlington. **Assert Oneself** (Affirmed), on the board in 9-of-11 this year, finished second to **Aube Indienne** (Fr) (Bluebird) in the Gill Modesty at Arlington in June, but was moved up when the top one was disqualified right out of the money. French import **Aube Indienne** has one official win from her five American starts.
