## THUNDER RUMBLE RETURNS TO GLORY

Two years, nine starts and a surgery have passed since his victory in the 1992 Travers, and the now five-year-old **Thunder Rumble** (Thunder Puddles) showed yesterday that his glory days are not yet over, defeating five other GI winners en route to a four-length triumph in the Saratoga Cup. For most of this year the horse was stabled in Southern California, where he set upon a four-race losing streak that prompted his return to trainer Richard O'Connell and Saratoga Racecourse in the hopes of recapturing his former brilliance. "Well, the first thing is--I'm happy to have not only the owners back but especially the horse," said O'Connell. "I have to thank Chris (trainer Speckert), who had the horse in California, because when the horse came to me, he was already fit. More than likely, I'll run him in the Whitney. This horse does well up here, so that's where you'll probably see him next." Winning jockey Richard Migliore said of his trip aboard Thunder Rumble, "I always had a lot of horse under me. I asked him at the quarter pole and he just took off. He's tremendous." Rusty Arnold, trainer of race favorite and second-place finisher **West By West** (Gone West), said of his late-running charge, "He ran well today and I was happy with his performance. He was pretty far back and the race didn't come back until late. We plan to put him in the Whitney if he comes back healthy." Saratoga's GI \$350,000 Whitney is scheduled for Sat., Aug. 27.

## TWILIGHT RACING A SUCCESS AT DEL

**MAR** Friday's experiment at Del Mar with twilight racing was a success from every perspective, and the consensus of opinion from horsemen and management was that the trial run proved to be a positive for racing in general and Del Mar in particular. The numbers for Friday's races are as follows: On-track attendance was 18,797 compared to last year's total for the same day of 12,430, an increase of 49 percent. Off-track attendance rose to 18,504, compared to last year's 16,651. The handle for the shortened card of eight races went up to \$8,194,656, compared to last year's total of \$6,669,385 for a full nine-race card. Said trainer Gary Jones, "There were a lot of people here, a lot of new faces. The main thing is for the good of the game and I think it's a great deal. Anything that brings new people is great."

"I thought I was on the best mare going in and my chief goal was to put her in a position where she could win," said winning rider Chris McCarron. "I had a dream trip. I got clear on the outside and my mare fired. She's special. She's surely the best mare I've ever ridden on grass. Without a doubt." Runner-up Hollywood Wildcat trailed the field entering the stretch and, despite a strong finish, was unable to catch Flawlessly in time to stop her from taking her 3rd straight Ramona. Heavy wagering on the two favorites created a \$17,623.98 minus show pool.

## DRAMATIC GOLD JOINS PACIFIC CLASSIC

**LINEUP** Golden Eagle Farm is planning to send an entymate along with **Best Pal** (\*Habitony) in the Aug. 13 \$1,000,000 Pacific Classic at Del Mar. According to Racing Manager Gayle Van Leer, the addition of three-year-old gelding **Dramatic Gold** (Slew o' Gold) to the Classic lineup has been in the planning stages for some time. "After he ran in (and won) an allowance race at Hollywood (June 25), we decided to send the second nomination payment; and then after the Swaps (July 23) we were definite," said Van Leer. **Dramatic Gold** finished second in the Swaps to **Silver Music** (Silver Ghost), a supplementary entry to this year's Classic and the only other three-year-old pointing to the race. John Shirreffs, trainer of **Bertrando** (Skywalker), said the five-year-old will have a seven-furlong tightener Mon. with jockey Pat Valenzuela aboard. Trainer Gary Jones indicated **Stuka** (Jade Hunter) will breeze this morning before any definite decisions are made about his status.

## TRAVERS FIELD TAKING SHAPE Holy Bull

(Great Above) is scheduled to work five furlongs at Monmouth tomorrow morning in a prep for the Aug. 20 GI Travers Stakes at Saratoga. The Travers will be Holy Bull's first attempt at a mile and a quarter since he finished 12th as the Kentucky Derby favorite. "I have no qualms with the mile and a quarter," said his owner-trainer, Jimmy Croll, "but traditionally, the Travers has been the death site for favorites. The three-year-old route is a tough road." Travers-bound **Tabasco Cat** (Storm Cat) is scheduled to work Monday or Tuesday at Saratoga. "I'll decide how long he goes after I see the track," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas. The connections of Birmingham Budweiser Derby winner **Danville** (Demons Begone) are also eyeing the \$750,000 race. "It's a monumental task for him," said trainer Blackie Huffman. "He's really way behind those horses. We're just going to observe the horse for a while before we decide. We'll see if we think he warrants a chance with that kind of company." **Party Manners** (Private Account), who ran his record to four-for-four with a nose win in an allowance Friday at Saratoga, may also point to the Travers. "He showed a lot of heart in that race," said trainer Shug McGaughey's assistant, Buzz Tenney. "I would think the Travers is a big possibility."
