HALL OF FAME INDUCTIONS TODAY Today at the National Museum of Racing and Hall of Fame in Saratoga Springs, NY, a new group of racing legends will be formally inducted into The Official National Thoroughbred Racing Hall of Fame. This year's inductees are: Jockey **Steve Cauthen**, the youngest person to enter the Hall of Fame, the last jockey to win the Triple Crown (aboard Affirmed in '78) and the winner of the Kentucky, English, French, Irish and Italian derbys; **Warren "Jimmy" Croll**, trainer of Mr. Prospector, Housebuster and three-year-old sensation Holy Bull; Paul Mellon's champion **Arts and Letters**; the great sprinting filly **Ta Wee**; 1936 Horse of the Year **Eight Thirty**; and steeplechase champion **Flatterer**. The induction ceremony, open to the public, will take place from 10:30 to 11:30 a.m. under the tent on the lawn of the Hall of Fame.

STUKA LIKELY FOR PACIFIC CLASSIC Allen Paulson's **Stuka** (Jade Hunter) worked seven furlongs at Del Mar yesterday morning in preparation for Saturday's \$1,000,000 Pacific Classic. Jockey Laffit Pincay Jr. was aboard for the four-year-old colt's clocking of 1:25 4/5. Marty Jones, assistant to trainer Gary Jones, said Stuka is almost certain to compete in the GI Classic. Trainer Bruce Jackson said the 10-furlong test is still a strong possibility for his French import **Risen Roman** (Risen Star). The four-year-old, who was third in his only U.S. start, a Hollywood turf allowance July 21, breezed five furlongs Thurs. at Del Mar in :59 1/5. **Best Pal** (*Habitony) is slated to prep Wednesday for the race. "He just went a mile, so he just needs a little blowout in-between," said his trainer Richard Mandella yesterday.

PHILADELPHIA PARK CLOSED FOR LIVE RACING Philadelphia Park will be closed for live racing from Mon., Aug. 8 through Thurs., Aug. 25 so that a number of maintenance projects, chief among them the resurfacing of the main dirt track, can be performed. Live racing will resume Fri., Aug. 26 with the track's premier race of the year, the GI, \$200,000 Pennsylvania Derby, set to be run Labor Day, Monday, Sept. 5. Philadelphia Park, which has conducted Thoroughbred racing continuously since June, 1990, will continue to conduct full-card simulcasting daily throughout the 18-day break.
