HOUSEBUSTER COLT TOPS SARATOGA'S FIRST SESSION A bay colt from the first crop of two-time champion sprinter **Housebuster** (Mt. Livermore) topped last night's first session of the 74th Annual Saratoga Select Yearling Sales, held at The Humphrey S. Finney Pavilion in Saratoga Springs, New York. The colt, sold as hip 39, is out of the multiple graded stakes-winning mare **Shy Dawn**, and is a half-brother to three stakes winners, including GI Breeders' Cup Mile champion **Opening Verse** and GIII Columbiana H. winner **So She Sleeps** (Seattle Slew). Consigned to the sale by Jonabell Farm Inc. as agent for J.D. Wimpfheimer, the colt was purchased for \$510,000 by F. Eugene Dixon. The second-highest price of the session was brought by hip 72, a chestnut filly by **Gone West--Dancing Rags**, by Nijinsky II. The filly, a half-sister to graded stakes-placed **Dance Account**, was consigned to the sale by Walnut Green (Jones Bros.), agent and purchased for \$325,000 by Paraneck Stable. Overall, 56 yearlings were sold for a gross of \$5,556,000 and an average of \$99,214, a 12.6 percent increase from last year's first session average of \$88,135. There were 17 horses listed as unsold. The final two sessions of the sale will take place tonight and Thursday night at 8 p.m.

December Hill Farm's **Changing Ways** (Time for a Change), winner of the Saratoga's opening day feature, the GIII Schuylerville, breezed three furlongs in :36 4/5 Sunday in her final preparation for the race. Jockey Mike Smith, who guided her to victory in the Schuylerville, has opted instead to ride Edward A. Cox Jr.'s **Appointed One** (Danzig) for trainer Shug McGaughey. Smith was aboard **Appointed One** in her only start July 14 at Belmont, when she sailed to a front-running, two-length victory over the turf course.

SAPLING S.-GII, \$200,000, 2yo, 6f
 Among those likely to run in the Sapling are **Ruxton Rider** (Prospector's Gamble), **Mane Ingredient** (Miswaki), **Tony Riccio** (Pappa Riccio), **Enlighten** (Stacked Pack), **Boone's Mill** (Carson City) and **Western Echo** (Eastern Echo). The latter three will have to be supplemented to the race at a cost of \$12,500 each. The Bill Perry-trained **Enlighten** took the \$50,000 Tyro S. at Monmouth on Haskell day to remain undefeated in three career starts. "We were very surprised with his races," said Perry. "We hoped he would break his maiden quickly, and then look for claiming races for him. When the claimers weren't available, we entered him in the non-winners of two. He ran so well we felt he deserved a shot in the stakes." **Enlighten** is scheduled to breeze either three-eighths or a half-mile at Monmouth this morning. **Boone's Mill** started his campaign at Churchill Downs, breaking his maiden at first asking before placing second in the GIII Bashford Manor. He was then shipped up to Saratoga for another runner-up finish, this time in the GII Sanford S. Another who is multiple stakes-placed in only three career starts is **Mane Ingredient**, whose two stakes performances followed a 9 1/2-length maiden victory at Belmont.

DIANA H.-GII, \$125,000a, 3yo/up, f/m, 9fT

According to Jonathan Sheppard's assistant trainer, Ben Guessford, **Alice Springs** (Val de l'Orne {FR}), winner of the GII Matchmaker S. July 30 at Atlantic City, will make her next start in the Diana H. "She came out of her run in the Matchmaker in good shape," said Guessford. I'm not quite sure when she'll breeze next, but she is scheduled to run in the Diana." Trainer Christophe Clement has nominated four of his fillies, but it is likely he will only start two. "Well, with Alice Springs, **Via Borghese** (Seattle Dancer) and **Elizabeth Bay** (Mr. Prospector) in that race, it will be extremely tough," he said. "I will probably run **La Piaf** (FR) (Fabulous Dancer) and **Cox Orange** (Tremolino) in there." Cox Orange won three stakes in three starts this year before finishing third to Alice Springs in the Matchmaker in her last outing. Bill Mott trainee Elizabeth Bay, a stakes-winner in both North America and France, hopes to bounce back from a disappointing eighth-place finish in the July 27 Saratoga Budweiser Breeders Cup. Also scheduled to go postward is Tom Skiffington trainee **Garendare** (GB) (Vacarme), third in last year's running of the Diana. "My horse is doing real well, but the Diana has come up so tough," said Skiffington. "I believe we have an outside shot in there. I'll probably wait to decide until I know for sure who is going to run in there."
