KING'S THEATRE TOPS JUDDMONTE

INTERNATIONAL King's Theatre (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), recent winner of the King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S., has been installed as the 6-4 favorite for Tuesday's Juddmonte International at York in England. Trainer Henry Cecil said Friday, "He is in very good order and definitely goes to York. Then we'll give him a break before bringing him back for either the Champion S. or the Arc." Also expected for the Group I, mile-and-a-quarter event are **Alflora** (Nininski), **Bob's Return (Ire)** (Bob Back), **Chatoyant (GB)** (Rainbow Quest), **Ezzoud (Ire)** (Last Tycoon), **Grand Lodge** (Chief's Crown), **Muhtarram** (Alleged), **Spartan Shareef** (Shareef Dancer) and **Turtle Island** (Fairy King). Irish 2000 Guineas winner Turtle Island, who had been pointing for Sunday's Prix du Haras de Fresnay-le-Buffard Jacques le Marois, was slightly lame after stepping on a stone but it is believed he will be ready for the Juddmonte.

CASINO BOOSTS HOLLYWOOD'S INTER-TRACK BUSINESS

Stimulated by brisk business at the new Hollywood Park casino, inter-track handle and attendance figures at Hollywood Park are running at a record clip for the Del Mar meeting. For the first time, Hollywood has become the leading satellite site. Handle has averaged \$1.2 million for the first 12 days of the Del Mar meet. "A lot of people said the Casino would hurt racing," said R. D. Hubbard, Hollywood's chief executive officer. "But we made it easy for card players to bet the races with plenty of betting windows and bet runners, and it's paying off. Because of the Casino, our numbers are way up and still improving." Said Tom Bowling, Casino general manager, "Betting on the races has been very popular with card players. They like the extra action. And when one or two players bet and win, the whole table usually jumps in on the next race. They use the bet runners and never leave the table." Attendance at Hollywood Park averaged 5,287 during Del Mar's opening week and 6,429 the second week, an increase of 21.6 percent. The daily average attendance through 12 days, 5,858, is up 8.5 percent from 1993, while the daily average handle is up 10 percent from a year ago.

Evening up the score in a torrid rivalry, Lure made it three wins apiece against arch rival PARADISE CREEK (Irish River {FR}). Content to let eventual third-place finisher FOURSTARDAVE (Compliance) lead through 3/4, MGSW Lure took up the chase on the far turn and picked up his 3rd of 5 this year, running the last eighth in a sizzling :11 3/5. MGSW Paradise Creek shadowed Lure the entire contest, but couldn't get by in the run down the lane. "After his two losses, people got off him," said Lure's rider, Mike Smith. "It bothered me. That happy gesture I gave after the race was to show that Lure is still there. He's an incredible horse. If you look up champion in the dictionary, you'll find a picture of him." Trainer Shug McGaughey said the five-year-old would make his next start in the Kelso at Belmont Park. Trainer Bill Mott said of the runner-up, "We would have preferred a faster pace, but we didn't have it. It was probably to Lure's advantage. The track was also quite hard and that was also to Lure's liking. I think my horse just got outrun by Lure. He probably got a little tired the last eighth, but he still ran a great race." Paradise Creek will be pointed for the Arlington Million.

Thoro-Graph Analysis

The key to betting on a horse like **Bertrando** (Sky-walker) is to find a time when he is fit enough to run a good one, but hasn't run so fast recently as to hurt himself--which is exactly what happened last fall. After posting a negative Thoro-Graph number in the Woodward, he bounced enough to get beat in the Breeders' Cup Classic and disappeared from sight.

Now, once again, the stars are in proper alignment. Bertrando is running his second race off a layoff, and that first race was a non-effort that should set him up nicely. Better yet, this is not a handicap, and best of all, we might actually get 2-1 on the best horse in the race, at weight for age, on a day he figures to run well. *Thoro-Graph sheets, state-of-the-art performance figures, are used by many industry professionals to evaluate the ability of racehorses. Let's start with the most important part--**Lakeway** (Seattle Slew) is in the wrong race. If she ran back to her last two Thoro-Graph figures, she would be even money to beat the colts in the Travers, given the weight allowance for her sex. If she doesn't run that well, there is a filly in the Alabama good enough to beat her--and it's not the morning-line second choice.

Two Altazano (Manzotti) has come a long way since her slow two-year-old figures, but she's still several lengths shy of Lakeway, and further short-term progress is not likely. She has come too far, too fast. **Heavenly Prize** (Seeking the Gold), however, is another story. She managed to catch two of the fastest races of the year in her last two. Although the distance is obviously a question, at least we'll get a price on the answer--Heavenly Prize has not won since October. Three of the six entrants, GI Sanford runner-up **Boone's Mill** (Carson City), undefeated Tyro victor **Enlighten** (Stacked Pack) and 13-length maiden winner **Western Echo** (Eastern Echo), were all supplemented to the race at a cost of \$12,500.
