HOLY BULL PREPS FOR TRAVERS; LUKAS

MAY RUN RABBIT Holy Bull (Great Above) had his final serious workout for the Travers S. yesterday morning at Monmouth Park, going six furlongs in 1:12 1/5. "He went easy; he was going evenly the whole way," said owner/trainer Jimmy Croll. "He leaves for Saratoga in one week." But the speedy grey will not have things his own way on the front end next Saturday, as trainer D. Wayne Lukas is leaning towards running a rabbit in the GI event. Lukas has nominated **Commanche Trail** (Copelan) and said yesterday that he is likely to enter him. Owned by William T. Young, who also holds a half-interest in **Tabasco Cat** (Storm Cat), the three-year-old finished fifth in the Screen King S. in his last start; he is a six-furlong specialist who won an allowance June 1 at Belmont in 1:10 1/5. "If there's going to be a small field, I'd tend to run him," Lukas said of Commanche Trail. "Of course, there's a question of whether the rabbit can make the lead, and how long he'll stay there. This wouldn't be the first time someone has done this. Damascus had his rabbit, so did Strike the Gold. There's a mystique to this thing. He'd be in there to insure a good pace. We're not going to have him blast off and we wouldn't be running him against any one horse. We'd just want to make sure there's a realistic pace." A small field is likely for the race. Jim Dandy winner **Unaccounted For** (Private Account) is the only other definite; **Concern** (Broad Brush) and **Ulises** (Temperence Hill) are possible starters.

FOURSTARDAVE INJURED IN BARUCH Veteran New York-bred **Fourstardave** (Compliance), third after setting the pace in Friday's Bernard Baruch H. at Saratoga, injured an ankle in the race and will be out for the rest of the year. "He severely twisted his ankle, the left front," said trainer Leo O'Brien. "Richie (Migliore) thought it happened when they were turning for home. He just took a bad step. You could see he just didn't finish up the way he usually does...when we brought him back and cooled him out, that's when we could really see he was hurt. His leg is wrapped and he's comfortable. We'll keep him here in the stall for a while and give him the rest he needs. That will be it for him this year. We'll be back next year." The gelding will be 10 in 1995.

Beaten just a neck in the Gil Bel Air H. at a mile and a sixteenth last time out, Tinners Way stretched out to 10 furlongs and closed off a torrid early pace to take the lead at the top of the stretch and hold Best Pal safe by a length at the line, equalling the track record in the process. "This is the most gratifying win," said his trainer, Bobby Frankel, who took this race last year with Bertrando. "He was coming into the race great. He's been a little unlucky, this horse. He got lucky at the right time." Last year's winner and this year's 5-2 favorite, Bertrando was in front through opening fractions of :21 3/5 and :44 2/5, but tired badly and finished eighth. Said his rider, Pat Valenzuela, "Twenty-one, :44--how can you do that and keep on going? You can't. He didn't. Too fast." Runner-up Best Pal picked up another \$200,000 and is now third all-time leading money winner behind Alysheba and John Henry with \$4,973,645 in the bank; he needs more than \$1.7 million to take over the top spot.

Lightly raced Heavenly Prize, who had not visited the winner's circle since her impressive victory in last year's GI Frizette S. but never off the board, came back from a third-place finish in the GI Test and rallied from fourth to take over from overwhelming choice Lakeway at the top of the stretch and gallop home as much the best. "I knew all along that she was begging to run long," said trainer Shug McGaughey, who teamed up with jockey Mike Smith Friday to win the Bernard Baruch with Lure. "She got sick in Florida and I couldn't do what I wanted with her. We did beat a good filly; now that I am able to do what I can do with her, we have a great filly, too." This was the third Alabama win for McGaughey, who also scored with Classy Cathy ('86) and Versailles Treaty ('91); owner Ogden Phipps had one previous Alabama winner, Busanda in 1950. Jockey Kent Desormeaux aboard the runner-up, said, "When I asked her to kick in when Heavenly Prize came to me, she had nothing. I don't think she was herself. I just got outrun at the end."

After beginning her career in France, Pennsylvania-bred **Alice Springs** (Val de l'Orne) shipped back to NA and has since won four of her five starts, including the GII Matchmaker S. in her latest effort. "Mr. Strawbridge always sends about half of his yearling crop to Europe," explained her trainer, Jonathan Sheppard. "She went to France and showed promise of being one of the best of her generation." But after disappointing with an eighth-place finish in the French Oaks, taking a vacation, and putting in another off-the-board performance in a smaller stakes, she was shipped to the U.S. "She showed a slight trace of blood in the trachea (after the Oaks)," Sheppard said. "She was given herbal treatments and was off two-and-a-half months. When she returned, she disappointed again." Since returning to NA, the filly has never been beaten while racing with Lasix; she also galloped home by nine in a Laurel allowance without benefit of the medication. Her lone loss stateside came in New York, when she finished fourth after a troubled trip in the Gill Sheepshead Bay H. in June.
