UNACCOUNTED FOR PREPS FOR TRAVERS
Grade II Jim Dandy winner **Unaccounted For** (Private Account) turned in a picture-perfect work yesterday morning for Saturday's \$750,000 Travers, going five-eighths in 1:00 2/5 over Saratoga's main track. "It was real nice," said trainer Scotty Schulhofer. "Jose (jockey Santos) said he'd have gone in :58 if he'd let him." The trainer also commented on his colt's chances Saturday, saying, "If he's as good a horse as I hope he is, he should do the job. For a young horse who doesn't have as much seasoning as he might, he's very professional. He's got a shot at it." Also possible for the Travers is Louisiana Derby winner **Kandaly** (Alydar). "We are planning on coming," said trainer Louie Roussel from his Arlington Park stable. "We'll enter and then decide. The Travers is a fantastic, prestigious race. Maybe we'll get lucky." **Copper Mount** (Cormorant) will have his final work this morning before a decision is made as to whether he will run. Also scheduled to breeze this morning is **Ulises** (Temperence Hill), third in the Jim Dandy. "What I liked about his last race was that he kept running--that's what we were waiting to see," said trainer Alfredo Callejas. **Concern** (Broad Brush), no worse than third in eight straight stakes appearances, will blow out three-eighths Fri. "He couldn't be coming into the race any better," said trainer Richard Small.

HOLLYWOOD TURF FESTIVAL NOMINEES ANNOUNCED A total of 127 foreign runners, including some of the highest-rated grass stars in Europe, are among the record 531 nominees to the seven stakes that comprise Hollywood Park's \$1.8 million Autumn Turf Festival scheduled for November 20-27. The \$150,000 Hollywood Mile for three-year-olds and up has been added to the stakes lineup for the fourth annual grass series, which also includes the GI Matriarch, GI Hollywood Derby, GII Citation H., GIII Generous S. and GIII Hollywood Turf Express.

ALFLORA (Niniski) and **King's Theatre** led through a moderate pace early. Entering the four-furlong straight, **Alflora** still led from **King's Theatre**, but with three furlongs to race **King's Theatre** took command, with **Ezzoud** soon racing into a challenging position and **Muhtarram** closing. With a furlong to race, **Ezzoud** took over and ran on well to resist the strong late challenge of **Muhtarram** by a neck. Winner at odds of 28-1 last year, **Ezzoud** is only the second horse to win this event twice. The other is the mare **Dahlia**, who also won the race two years running (1974-75). The winner is 1/2 to **Distant Relative (IRE)** (Ch. miler in Ire, Hwt older horse in Fr 7-9 1/2 furlongs, G2-Ire, G1-Eng, G1-Fr, \$970,668, by **Habitat**).

GRAND FINDS NEW LODGINGS; FUTURE UNCERTAIN FOR FOYER Grand Lodge (Chief's Crown), winner of Royal Ascot's St. James's Palace S. and fourth in yesterday's Juddmonte Int'l at York, will retire from racing at the end of this year and join the growing band of horses operating as stallions in both the Northern and Southern Hemispheres. In a joint deal, Ireland's Coolmore Stud and Woodlands Stud from Australia have agreed to buy a 75 percent stake in the three-year-old colt from owner-breeder Lord Howard de Walden. Meanwhile, career plans for Foyer (Sadler's Wells), another Ascot hero, are in serious doubt following a tendon injury. Foyer, a scorer in the King Edward VII S., damaged his near-foreleg while out exercising Sunday and was forced to miss Tuesday's St. Leger trial, the Great Voltigeur S. "The injury is pretty bad and he won't run again this season," said trainer Michael Stoute. "It's too early to say if he'll be able to continue racing as a four-year-old."

SARATOGA HORSES OF RACING AGE AND OPEN TWO-YEAR-OLDS IN TRAINING SALE RESULTS

During yesterday's Fasig-Tipton Saratoga Horses of Racing Age Sale in Saratoga Springs, New York, 62 head were sold for a gross of \$533,300 and an average of \$8,602, down a slight 2.4 percent from last year's average of \$8,811. Bringing top price of \$51,000 was Coffee Commercial, a three-year-old filly by Java Gold--T.V. Bee (T.V. Commercial). Consigned to the sale by Kirkwood Stables, agent for the Estate of Edith Joan Elser, Coffee Commercial was purchased by Mike Ryan, agent. The Open Two-Year-Olds in Training Sale followed, reporting 36 juveniles sold for a total of \$393,700 and an average of \$10,936. Eight were listed as unsold. The sales topper was a gray filly by Two Punch--Wisely (Smarten), consigned by Muster Lane Farm and purchased by Ed Nearing for \$42,000.

Sunday, Monmouth:

PHILIP H. ISELIN H.-GI, \$250,000, 3yo/up, 9f Storm Tower (Irish Tower) drilled six furlongs at Monmouth yesterday in preparation for Sunday's Iselin. "He worked really well," said trainer Ben Perkins Jr. "He went in 1:11 2/5. He's in top shape. He's going to run well on Sunday." Despite the fact that confirmed frontrunners **Northern Trend** (Sunny North), **Williamstown** (Seattle Slew) and **Slick Horn** (Red Ryder) are considered possible starters, Perkins is not worried that Storm Tower will be caught up in a fast early

pace. "Rick Wilson has been riding him for a while and he knows how to ride him," said Perkins. "He doesn't have to be in front, but that's the way it's worked out for him in his last few starts. He's come from just off the pace. He ran that was in the Fountain of Youth and the Florida Derby and he's run well." Luv Or Nott Stable's **Mighty Avanti** (Big Spruce) worked five furlongs Monday in 1:02 1/5. "He did what we wanted him to do," said Assistant Trainer Terri Pompay. "He finished really well." King Leatherbury-trainee **Taking Risks** (Two Punch), a \$20,000 claim last November, is also being pointed to the Iselin. "He's a flat runner," said Leatherbury. "You can't work him slow even if you try. He just loves to run." The four-year-old gelding has won seven of nine starts and earned over \$240,000 since being claimed. Trainer Rusty Arnold is still trying to decide whether to run **West By West** (Gone West) in the Iselin. The horse went four furlongs over Saratoga's Oklahoma training track yesterday morning in :50 1/5 seconds.
