DEL MAR YEARLING SALE POSTS HUGE

GAINS Average prices took a 151.3 percent leap from 1993 during California Thoroughbred Sales' select yearling sale at Del Mar Tuesday. There were 49 yearlings sold for a total of \$960,500 and an average of \$19,602, up a remarkable 151.3 percent from last year's average of \$7,800. The median price was \$16,000, and six horses were listed as unsold. Top price of \$55,000 was bid for a chestnut filly by Woodman--Irish Royal (Irish River {FR}), consigned to the sale by Golden Eagle Farm, agent and purchased by Melvin F. Stute of Glendora, California. The filly is a half-sister to the graded stakes-placed four-year-old colt Star of the Eagle (Storm Bird).

MINER'S MARK TO LANE'S END Grade I winner **Miner's Mark** (Mr. Prospector), the first foal out of undefeated champion Personal Ensign, will enter stud in 1995 at William S. Farish's Lane's End Farm near Versailles, Kentucky. Bred and raced by Ogden Phipps and trained by Claude R. "Shug" McGaughey, the four-year-old colt captured last year's Jockey Club Gold Cup over 1 1/4-miles. His other stakes wins included the GII Jim Dandy and the GIII Colin S. He retires with earnings of \$967,170.

INJURY ENDS KISSING COUSIN'S CAREER

Kissing Cousin (Danahill), winner of the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot in June, has been retired after sustaining an injury to her pelvis. The filly is currently being treated at her home base at trainer Henry Cecil's Newmarket stables, but will be moved to one of owner Sheikh Mohammed's studs as soon as her condition improves. "It is thought she injured herself when she got cast in her box," said Anthony Stroud, the Sheikh's racing manager. "We were worried at first that she had fractured her pelvis, but although X-rays show there is no fracture, we will treat her as if that is what there has been."

BOLAS (Unfuwain) set a good pace, followed by HAWAJISS (Kris) and WANDESTA (Nashwan). That order was maintained until a half mile out, when Bolas still led but was being challenged on the outside by State Crystal, who swept into a clear lead and looked a possible winner, until Only Royale, who had been in the rear for much of the race, cruised up on the wide outside, took the lead with two furlongs to run and galloped away for an impressive six-length victory, repeating her success in the race a year ago. Dancing Bloom ran on well to beat State Crystal for second, also filling the same place she occupied in the 1993 running. Only Royale is the first horse to win the race two years running, but it only became an all-age fillies and mares race three years ago. Trainer Luca Cumani says the winner will attempt the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe and may take in the G3 Prix Foy at Longchamp, a race she won last year, on the way.

FOAL CROP ON THE RISE AFTER EIGHT-YEAR DECLINE

The Jockey Club is projecting a 1995 registered foal crop of 35,200, a two percent increase on the 1994 estimate of 34,600 and the first increase in annual foal crop numbers after eight consecutive years of decline. The projection is computed from Reports of Mares bred received for the 1994 breeding season. The North American registered foal crop reached an all-time high of 51,293 in 1986. Since then, numbers have declined each year resulting in an eight-year decline of 33 percent.

Saturday, Saratoga:

TRAVERS S.-GI, \$750,000, 3yo, 10f

Conditioner Jimmy Croll plans to leave Monmouth Park at 5 a.m. Fri. to bring **Holy Bull** (Great Above) to Saratoga for the Travers. The big gray is scheduled to blow out Thursday. Trainer D. Wayne Lukas reported that **Tabasco Cat** (Storm Cat) was "full of himself" during his routine gallop over Saratoga's Oklahoma training track yesterday morning. "I'd have to say he was pretty sharp," said Lukas. "He had a lot of energy built up in him since yesterday was his

off day." **Unaccounted For** (Private Account) came out of Tuesday's work fine, according to trainer Scotty Schulhofer. Because the current forecast calls for showers Wed. and Thurs. with a chance of thunderstorms Fri. and Sat., the trainer expressed his concern about an off track: "I don't think he's at his best on a wet track. A little wet is fine--a whole lot wet, he won't be able to run." Trainer Louie Roussel is still unsure whether **Kandaly** (Alydar) will start. "He worked three-quarters on Monday," Roussel said from Arlington. "He went in 1:16 and change; it was just a breeze. We're on the fence--we won't run if there are a lot of entries." Jerry Bailey will be aboard **Concern** (Broad Brush) in the race. **Copper Mount** (Cormorant) will not run, said trainer Anthony Margotta Jr. Wed. "He's not 100 percent ready for the race and we want to do what's best for the horse," the trainer explained. After **Ulises** (Temperence Hill) went five furlongs in 1:02 Wed., trainer Alfredo Callejas said there is a "70 percent chance" the colt will run in the Travers.

Sunday, Del Mar:

The 38th running of the Oaks will be headed by Mr. and Mrs. Jerry Moss' **Sardula** (Storm Cat), winner of the GI Kentucky Oaks. The Brian Mayberry trainee will be making her grass debut; Mayberry's wife and assistant Jeannie said Sardula has had three works over the local grass course and has handled herself well in all of them. San Clemente winner **Work the Crowd** (Political Ambition) drilled seven furlongs over the Del Mar turf Monday in 1:28 1/5. Trainer Alex Hassinger sent Allen Paulson's **Pharma** (Theatrical {IRE}), a close second in the San Clemente, out for a six-furlong breeze on the grass yesterday morning with regular rider Corey Black up. She went in 1:12 2/5. Also expected to join the field are **Dancing Mirage** (Affirmed), **Malli Star** (Baldski) and **Twice the Vice** (Vice Regent).

Sunday, Monmouth:

ISELIN H.-GI, \$250,000, 3yo/up, 9f

Wallenda (Gulch) worked at Saratoga Tuesday, going five-eighths in 1:01 in his final preparation for the Iselin. "He worked very well, just what we wanted," said trainer Frank Alexander. "There is lots of speed in the race, which is what he needs, and a couple of closers, and that suits us just fine. He's just a hard-knocking horse that runs his race every time." The trainer indicated Wallenda will ship to Monmouth early Sunday morning. **Koluctoo Jimmy AI** (Jaques Who) drilled four furlongs yesterday at Monmouth in :48 and change. The 1993 Iselin winner **Valley Crossing** (Private Account) galloped yesterday morning at Pimlico. The Richard Small trainee is due at Monmouth this weekend. **It'sali'knownfact** (Known Fact) shipped up to the Jersey Shore from Florida Tues. "He galloped over the track today and handled it well," said trainer Cam Gambolati yesterday.
