## CHURCHILL REPORTS STRONG SECOND

**QUARTER** Churchill Downs Inc. reported revenues of \$39,968,720 for the second quarter of 1994, which ended June 30; the figure is \$1,311,490 higher than for the second quarter of 1993. Net earnings of \$10,469,618 for the period of April 1 through June 30 were \$606,341 above the same period last year, and earnings per share for the quarter were \$2.77, \$.16 higher than '93. Strong intertrack wagering at the Sports Spectrum in April, followed by a record-breaking spring meet at Churchill Downs, which was three days shorter than last year, generated the increases.

**CTHS SALES RESULTS** A total of 99 hips were sold for a gross of \$943,400 during the 1994 Canadian Thoroughbred Horse Society's Summer Yearling Sale (British Columbia division), held Tuesday. The average of \$9,529.29 was down 19 percent from last year, when 45 yearlings sold for \$530,700, an average of \$11,793.33. The sales topper was a colt by Mane Minister out of Ten Count; consigned by Leys Farm, the yearling went for a bid of \$56,000 to David Bowman.

**CHURCHILL DOWNS NAMES NEW VP** Churchill Downs Inc. President and CEO Tom Meeker announced yesterday the appointment of Don Richardson as Vice President, Racing. Richardson will be responsible for policy development, strategy and horsemen services for Churchill Downs and Hoosier Park in Indiana; he will also continue to serve as stakes coordinator. A 48-year-old native of Louisville, Richardson joined Churchill as stakes coordinator in August, 1990; his father ran the program department at Churchill for over 30 years.

The Ballerina is always one of the best races of the Saratoga meet. The long run to the only turn de-emphasizes luck, and, facing three-year-old fillies against their elders, it makes for a fascinating handicapping exercise.

In our piece in this space for the Alabama, we pointed out that Heavenly Prize was a major threat to Lakeway, having come out of two of the fastest races of the year. Well, in both those races, Penny's Reshoot (Turkey Shoot) finished ahead of her. The latest was a loss to Twist Afleet (Afleet), who surfaces again in the Ballerina. But Twist Afleet was getting a substantial weight break last time--not today.

Classy Mirage (Storm Bird) will undoubtedly be favored off her last two huge races, but she is giving Penny's Reshoot a weight concession worth three lengths at the distance. While there is some chance Penny's Reshoot will bounce off her last two, we'll take our chances at the price, and play her to win. *Thoro-Graph sheets, state-of-the-art performance figures, are used by many industry professionals to evaluate the ability of racehorses. #### HERB MCCAULEY RETURNS TO NEW

**JERSEY** Herb McCauley, a dominant rider on the New Jersey circuit for much of the 1980's, is returning to the Garden State after spending the past seven years as a member of the New York jockey colony. McCauley, a resident of New Jersey, said yesterday that he will ride regularly at the Meadowlands when it opens September 5, and that he plans to winter in Florida before returning to Monmouth; he feels the move will allow him to see more of his family. "I've been accepted in New Jersey in the past and have done quite well there," said McCauley. "I hope the reception will be just as good when I go back. I hope to do just as well there as I did before, and at the same time be able to spend more time with my family." McCauley, 37, is the second-leading rider in Meadowlands history with 740 victories.

#### BILL NADER NAMED NYRA DIRECTOR OF

**MARKETING** Bill Nader, for 10 years the Director of Media Relations, Marketing and Simulcasting at Rockingham Park, has been named the Director of Marketing for the New York Racing Association, Inc., it was announced yesterday. Nader will join the NYRA September 1. He replaces Philip Shaner, who resigned to pursue outside opportunities in marketing.

"We knew the horses wouldn't quicken on this ground, so we put the pressure on him early--that way the rest of the field would have to catch him," said winning jockey Craig Thompson. Mistico's trainer Jonathan Sheppard added, "My horse carried the highest weight, 168 pounds, in the history of Turf Writers." The win was Sheppard's eighth in this event.
