ESPN'S "RACING TO THE BREEDERS' CUP" CONTINUES SUNDAY The ESPN "Racing to the Breeders' Cup" series continues Sunday with a live doubleheader broadcast of the Philip Iselin H. from Monmouth Park and the John A. Morris H. from Saratoga. The broadcast of the two Grade I races will be from 4:00-5:00 p.m. EDT.

SMILIN SINGIN SAM RETIRED Dogwood Stable's **Smilin Singin Sam** (Smile), winner of the Remington Park Derby and on the board in seven of his 11 career starts, has been retired from racing. Tests at Ohio State University revealed that the three-year-old colt suffers from a malfunctioning heart valve. "Due to this disappointing diagnosis, we are currently discussing options as to where this colt can begin his stallion career," said Cot Campbell, president of Dogwood.

SIMULCASTING MOVES TO KEENELAND SATURDAY Beginning Saturday, wagering on Ellis Park and other major North American tracks will be concentrated at Keeneland. Saratoga, Arlington and Del Mar will join Ellis Park on the menu of tracks that the public can wager on and watch in the Keeneland grandstand. Betting on the National Best Seven will also be available. Wagering on at least one track will be offered daily throughout August. Belmont Park will join the schedule at the conclusion of Saratoga, and Woodbine will be offered on selected dates, beginning in September.

I thought she would run better, but she didn't seem to be handling the track." McGaughey added that Roamin Rachel would be pointed for the Kentucky Cup at Turfway Park.

Travers Thoro-Graph Analysis

Horses are not racecars. When a part in a car wears down, it gets replaced. Big efforts don't take anything out of a car, so they don't go in and out of form, or need time to recover.

Holy Bull (Great Above) has been in serious training and enduring serious stress since December, when he began gearing up for his three-year-old campaign. He has had a race every five weeks or less since late January, and has serious, fast workouts in between. On two occasions this year he has not felt like running, and spit it out completely--once after a lifetime top, and then after two in a row. Now he's coming off three huge races in a row, after a long, hard campaign, and going a mile and a quarter, probably on an off track. Is he the best horse? Yes. Will he win? Maybe. Are we going to try and beat him at 3-5? You bet your life.

While Holy Bull was working 9 to 5, his main rivals were hitting the beaches. Go for Gin will be well-rested for the fall, and is clearly the one to beat in the Breeders' Cup Classic. **Tabasco Cat** (Storm Cat) made his return in the Jim Dandy. We picked **Unaccounted For** (Private Account) in this space that day, factoring in a huge weight pull and the fact that trainer D. Wayne Lukas was pointing his colt for the Travers. We cashed that day, and the same logic makes us like Tabasco Cat today--level weights this time, and the target race.

The premise behind this bet is two-fold. Tabasco Cat will run his best race; Holy Bull will not. On days Holy Bull doesn't run, he doesn't run at all, so we'll look to play exactas against him. Tabasco Cat on top of **Concern** (Broad Brush) and **Unaccounted For**.
