MENAGERIE NO MATCH FOR THE

"BULL" Looking every bit the champion, **Holy Bull** (Great Above) overcame rapid fractions, early pressure from Team Lukas rabbit **Commanche Trail** (Copelan), a determined late challenge by **Concern** (Broad Brush) and the fabled "Graveyard of Favorites" yesterday to become the 125th winner of the GI Travers S. "He ran every step of the way," said jockey Mike Smith. "In the stretch, I saw Concern coming so I gave him a couple of love taps, because I never had to hit him before. It was a tremendous effort on his part. He showed he's a champ." Owner/trainer Jimmy Croll was equally impressed. "They tried all ways to beat him, but he did what he had to do. He did it without a race over the track and he did it without a work over the track, which they said couldn't be done. He proved them wrong. I think he proved what kind of horse he is today. He really had no breaks. He proved he's all heart." Preakness and Belmont winner **Tabasco Cat** (Storm Cat) was not able to take advantage of his stablemate's efforts; the colt struggled home third, 17 lengths behind the runner-up. "He didn't handle the track at all," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "I really need a dry track for him." Added jockey Pat Day, "At the seven-eighths pole he started slipping and sliding. There was still some wetness in the track, and he just couldn't handle it." Holy Bull, who is not Breeders' Cup eligible, will wrap up his three-year-old campaign in either the GI Woodward at Belmont or the Molson Million at Woodbine. Tabasco Cat will be pointed for the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup. Saratoga's on-track handle for Travers Day, \$6,562,051, as well as the total handle of \$17,175,200, was the second highest in the track's history; last year's Travers card produced the records of \$7,228,168 and \$17,670,784, respectively.

Tabasco Cat, reserved just off the pace while waiting for his entrymate to soften up the Bull, had no answer when asked for his run on the far turn and finished a well-beaten third.

Wallenda (Gulch), a fast-closing third in the Saratoga Cup last time out, is looking for his third win of 1994. "There's plenty of speed in there; you just have to hope it all backs up," said trainer Frank Alexander. "The two major speed horses, **Storm Tower** (Irish Tower) and **Northern Trend** (Sunny North)--well, one is on the inside of us and one is on the outside, but we'll be lagging so far behind early that it just doesn't matter." Another with early foot, **Taking Risks** (Two Punch) has won seven of nine starts this year, including a nose victory in the GIII Baltimore Budweiser Breeders' Cup H. last time he ran. He has not been worse than second in allowance and stakes company since being claimed for \$20,000 last November.

Basqueian (Bounding Basque), never worse than second in six starts this year, earned his first stakes victory with a resounding seven-length triumph in the Queen's Plate, but missed the second leg of the Canadian Triple when Queen's Plate runner-up Bruce's Mill turned the tables in the Prince of Wales S. He will try to hold his dirt form while switching to the turf, a surface he has not run well on in the past. The lone filly in the race **Alywow** (Alysheba) tries colts after taking the second division of the GIII Nijana S. on the Saratoga turf last time out. The 3xSW has won five of her 11 career starts. Last year's champion two-year-old colt in Canada, **Comet Shine** (Fappiano), winless in six tries this year, will try to get back on track. The colt, fifth in the Queen's Plate on the dirt, was a 2x stakes winner on grass last year.

MAMSELLE BEBETTE PREPS FOR MATCH

RACE John Forsythe's **Mamselle Bebette** (Copelan) blew out Friday for today's match-up with **Soviet Problem** (Moscow Ballet), going three furlongs in a rapid :33 2/5 over the Del Mar turf, nearly two seconds quicker than the second-fastest move on the work tab. "She's back to 100 percent now," said her trainer, Jack Van Berg. The two fillies will face off between today's fifth and sixth races at Del Mar, going five furlongs on the turf; it is the first time a race has been run at that distance over the Del Mar grass course.

LAUREL ANNOUNCES FALL STAKES

SCHEDULE Maryland Jockey Club Vice President Lenny Hale has announced a 36-race, \$3,685,000 stakes schedule for the fall meet at Laurel Race Course, which opens Tuesday, September 27 and concludes December 31. The meet will be highlighted by the International Turf Festival and the ninth Maryland Million. The two-day Turf Festival consists of four stakes: the GI \$600,000 Washington D.C. International and the GIII \$200,000 Laurel Dash Oct. 15 and the GII \$250,000 All Along S. and the \$150,000 Governor's Cup Oct. 16. The GIII Selima S. (Oct. 9) and the GIII Laurel Futurity (Oct. 10), which had been a part of the Turf Festival, have been moved back to the dirt at seven-and-a-half furlongs. The Maryland Million, to be run Oct. 1, will showcase Maryland-sired horses in 12 races, including the \$150,000 Classic and the \$125,000 Ladies.
