AVERAGE UP AT OBS SELECTED YEARLING

SALE The 1994 Ocala Breeders' Sales Selected Yearling Sale, held yesterday, saw 198 lots sold for a gross of \$5,989,000. The number sold was up 10 percent from the 165 auctioned in 1993; the average for the '94 sale, \$30,247, was 8.7 percent higher than last year's average of \$27,818. The sales topper, part of the 61-horse Mockingbird consignment, was **Dawn Skier**, a filly by Baldski--New Dawn (Green Dancer) which went to the Paraneck Stable for a bid of \$150,000. Two more Mockingbird fillies brought bids of \$135,000: **Valid Agreement**, a chestnut by Valid Appeal--Happy Cherokee (Cherokee Fellow) purchased by Mike Rutherford; and **Valid Triumph**, by Valid Appeal--Smoke On Water (Gallant Romeo), a half sister to stakes winners Miss Iron Smoke and Peace Waters, who went to Jan, Mace and Samantha Siegel. A total of 32 yearlings were not sold.

KENTUCKY DERBY WINNER ON SCHEDULE FOR FOREGO H.

Kentucky Derby winner **Go for Gin** (Cormorant), off since finishing second in the GI Belmont S. June 11, is ready to make his return against older sprinters in Wednesday's GI Forego H. at Saratoga. "A lot of people are concerned about the distance," said his trainer, Nick Zito. "A lot of people don't think he's going to win going seven furlongs with the layoff and everything. But the 'Gin-Man' has raised himself to a new level. He looks absolutely beautiful."

SILVER MUSIC SIDELINED Trainer Wallace Dollase reported yesterday morning that Swaps S. winner **Silver Music** (Silver Ghost) will be out until next year because of chip in his ankle. The three-year-old underwent surgery Sunday at Los Alamitos. "We'll bring him back into training in three months and he'll be ready to run in about six," said Dollase.

Saturday, Saratoga

GI \$350,000 **Whitney H.**, 3yo/up, 9f

Devil His Due (Devil's Bag) will try for his third straight graded stakes victory Saturday. The five-year-old will be making his first start since taking the second and third legs on New York's Handicap Triple, the GI Brooklyn (June 18) and GI Suburban (July 4); he breezed a mile in 1:40.12 at Saratoga Sunday. "We're happy so far," said trainer Allen Jerkens. "We figured we'd give him some time and run him in this race, and hopefully have him ready for a couple more in the fall." The winner of \$3,362,485 was third in last year's Whitney. Back for another try in this year's edition of the race is '93 winner **Brunswick** (Private Account). A Saratoga allowance winner August 7 after a 10-month layoff, the Tony Margotta trainee will breeze a half-mile Wednesday. Also pointing for the GI event are Saratoga Cup winner **Thunder Rumble** (Thunder Puddles), undefeated in three starts at Saratoga, and last year's Whitney runner-up **West By West** (Gone West), who was second in the Saratoga Cup last time out.

Sunday, Del Mar

GI \$200,000a **Chula Vista H.**, 3yo/up, f/m, 8.5f

Two-time champion mare **Paseana** (Arg) (Ahmad {Arg}) makes her first start since taking the GI Santa Margarita H. March 6. The seven-year-old has won 12 of her 21 NA starts, all of them stakes and 10 of them Grade 1's; she has bankrolled \$2,757,112. Trainer Ron McAnally will also send out **Exchange** (Explodent) as part of the Sidney Craig entry. The six-year-old captured the '92 running of the Chula Vista. The 8xSW has been on the board in all three starts this year, including a victory in the Bayakoa H. at Del Mar in her most recent start. Finishing in the runner-up spot in the Bayakoa was four-year-old **Glass Ceiling** (Pirate's Bounty), who is also possible for this race. Lightly raced, the filly has been first or second in all seven career starts. She earned her first black-type triumph in her '94 bow July 21, winning the Pro Or Con S. at Hollywood after an eight-and-a-half month vacation. Trainer Darrell Vienna will send out **Golden Klair** (GB) (Damister), a winner of 10 of her 28 starts, with consecutive victories in the A Gleam H. and Hawthorne H. at Hollywood and the Lafayette Breeders' Cup H. at Golden Gate this year. The four-year-old was third in the GI Vanity H. last time out.

Unraced at two and with just four starts last year, the four-year-old closed steadily from last in the 12-horse field to take command in midstretch and draw clear by 3 1/2 lengths at 5-1. Highland Tootsie is a 1/2 to Forlana (*Forli), MSW, \$146,814; McCann (*Forli), MGSW, \$282,845; and a full to Blade of the Ball, SW, \$443,082. Lifetime Record: 9-1-1-2, \$28,240.

Puzar, a Del Mar allowance winner last out, rallied from fourth to get the runner-up spot. Dinand, sent off the 7-5 favorite in his first outing since March, faded in the drive. Snowtin, GSP in Argentina and making his American debut, tired in his first start since December.
