HOLY BULL ON COURSE FOR WOODWARD

Trainer Jimmy Croll reported yesterday morning from his Monmouth barn that **Holy Bull** (Great Above) is "doing fine" after his neck victory in the Travers. "He's better than ever," said Croll. "We're giving him a chance to rest before he works again." Croll noted that 'The Bull' has galloped over the Monmouth track the last three days; the owner/trainer is looking forward to his colt's next engagement in the Sept. 17 Woodward at Belmont. "I hope all those other horses don't run," said Croll. "Just make sure that Zito (trainer Nick) runs in it. Everybody's got a lot to say about me not putting up the money for the Breeders' Cup. Just make sure **Go For Gin** (Cormorant) is there."

KITWOOD TO LANE'S END Group I winner **Kitwood** (Nureyev) has been retired from racing and will enter stud in 1995 at William S. Farish's Lane's End Farm near Versailles, Kentucky. Produced from top racemare and broodmare Kittiwake, Kitwood is a half-brother to three stakes winners, including MGISW winner Miss Oceana. Bred by Lazy Lane Farms Inc. and raced by Sheikh Mohammed al Maktoum, Kitwood won from ages two to five in France and was on the board in 11 of 15 starts. In his only start in the U.S., he was third by 1 1/2-lengths to Paradise Creek and Bien Bien in the GI Hollywood Derby. Kitwood will stand for \$7,500 live foal, as the property of a partnership.

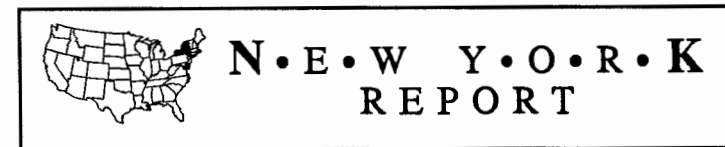

"But Bick always has been a nice colt, and he's not doing anything that tells me not to go. He'll learn a lot from the race and we'll get a better gauge on him." Describing his runner, Nafzger said, "He's a balanced little horse. He looks small, but we measured him and he stands 16 hands. He's by Manila, who seemed to start off great as a sire then tailed off, but he seems to be coming back. And he's getting the kind of horse maybe you wouldn't guess he'd get--good two-year-olds and good dirt horses. Looks like he's going to be a heck of a sire."

CHRB APPROVES DRUG RULES The California Horse Racing Board Friday approved several rules aimed at defining and classifying all prohibited drug substances; it also approved a \$375,000 drug testing contract which will greatly expand the California testing program's ability to detect prohibited substances in racehorses. The contract, with Iowa State University, requires the use of state-of-the-art equipment. "Using this technology, which was developed in the United Kingdom and Australia, we will have the ability to test for a much broader spectrum of drugs that can influence the outcome of a race," said Dr. Bob Jack, CHRB's equine medical director. Among the drug-related rules approved by the Board was one which classifies prohibited drug substances into seven categories ranging from potent stimulants and depressants (Class 1), to drugs routinely used in health care, such as anti-fungal agents and excess levels of authorized medications (Class 7). The Board referred a related rule for the establishment of penalty guidelines to its Medication Committee for further consideration.

IRS FILES LIEN AGAINST ROBERT LIBUTTI

The Internal Revenue Service yesterday filed a lien against any ownership interest Robert Libutti may have in Devil His Due, one of the favorites in today's Whitney. As there is no indication that anyone other than Edith Libutti holds an interest in the horse, Devil His Due will be allowed to compete pending further investigation.
