JET SETTER HATOOF FLAWLESS IN

BEVERLY D Hatoof (Irish River {Fr}), who had already won stakes in England, France and Canada, added the United States to her list of countries conquered, flying into Chicago and flying down the stretch to win the GI Beverly D at Arlington by a half-length over a game **Flawlessly** (Affirmed). "She only arrived three days ago, which makes the effort even that much more impressive, a big win in a big race," said her trainer, Criquelette Head. "She was 18 hours on the plane. Everything was against her. I think she's one of the best fillies in the world today." The five-year-old will return home Monday to get ready for a try at her second straight GI Champion S. at Newmarket in October; she is scheduled to be retired to the breeding shed at the end of the year.

FOURSTARDAVE UNDERGOES SURGERY

New York-bred millionaire **Fourstardave** (Compliance) underwent surgery Friday to repair damage to his left front ankle. "He's doing very good," said trainer Leo O'Brien. "Dr. Bramlage put two screws in his ankle and said there is a ninety-five percent chance that he'll run again."

PURSES UP AT BAY MEADOWS Purses for the 1994-95 Bay Meadows meet, which opened Friday, have been raised 7.5 percent across the board. "The raise is predicated on wagering at the San Mateo County Fair," said Bay Meadows President and CEO F. Jack Liebau. Total handle at the '94 San Mateo County Fair, which featured full-card simulcasting from Del Mar and Ferndale, was \$27,549,708, up 43 percent from the '93 meet. The average daily handle of \$2,295,809 was up 19.8 percent, despite the fact that betting on non-thoroughbred events was down 40 percent. The purse increase does not apply to stakes or overnight handicaps.

Content to settle at the back of the pack through the early fractions, Hatoof commenced her rally after three-quarters; the GISW found clear running room on the outside for the stretch run, dueling with Flawlessly until the final strides, when she edged to clear to gain her first U. S. victory in her second try. Flawlessly, who was awarded the win in the '93 Beverly D by the stewards after finishing second, had to settle for the place in a game effort. The longest shot on the board at 34-1, Potridee rallied from midfield to gain the show, missing the win by only a length.

Rebounding from two off-the-board performances in his last two starts, '93 Belmont S. winner Colonial Affair made a move from the outside on the far turn which gave him a clear lead at the top of the stretch, and he had just enough left in reserve to hold off a determined Devil His Due, who was giving the winner eight pounds, by a nose in the stretch drive. "We were in front one jump past the wire, but that doesn't count," said Mike Smith, rider of the runner-up. Said winning trainer Scotty Schulhofer of Colonial Affair, "He needed that last race. He ran the way I expected him to. I never lost confidence in him." Devil His Due will be pointed for the Woodward, while Colonial Affair is likely to wait for the Jockey Club Gold Cup. THUNDER RUMBLE (Thunder Puddles), the 7-5 favorite, was in good position just off the pace in fourth, but had no rally and finished fifth. "He was going well down the backside; I wouldn't have traded anyone for the position that we had," said his jockey, Richard Migliore. "Then he came out of the bridle. I don't know what happened."
