THUNDER RUMBLE INJURED IN

WHITNEY The racing career of **Thunder Rumble** (Thunder Puddles), the 7-5 favorite who finished fifth in Saturday's Whitney Handicap, is being threatened by an injury to a ligament in his left front leg. "It looked like it happened about the 4 1/2-furlong pole," said trainer Richie O'Connell. "Before that, he was on the bridle. There is some hemorrhaging inside. It's impossible to tell at this point if it's only the ligament or more. That will be accomplished with an ultrasound examination which we'll do in about a week. That will tell us a lot more where we stand." O'Connell said the injury was packed in poultice overnight, and was much improved Sunday morning. "The site of the injury looks much better than when we did it up (Saturday) night," said O'Connell. "We're going to attack it very aggressively. I know he could be returned to racing, but there is some stud value, so that will be a decision the Widmers will have to make when the time comes."

OTB/NYRA MERGER A STEP CLOSER

New York Governor Mario Cuomo announced yesterday that the investment firm of Bear, Stearns has been commissioned to write a model business plan for the merger of on and off-track betting operations in the State of New York. Off-track betting in New York is conducted by six regional OTB districts, while on-track operations are controlled by the New York Racing Association Inc. Cuomo made his remarks at a press conference following a meeting with the Governor's Advisory Commission on Racing in the 21st Century at the National Museum of Racing in Saratoga Springs, New York. While not the first time Cuomo has made it known that he would like to merge OTB and NYRA, no formal plans to enact a merger had been made known prior to yesterday. "There are all sorts of possibilities," he said. "We could merge the two, strengthen them and sell it privately, but there is a question of who buys it. Whatever happens has to be for the good of racing. We want to keep the quality of racing as high as possible while finding ways of making money without hurting racing."

Sent off the 9-5 choice in the full 14-horse field, Paradise Creek went after Fanmore, who had led from the start, at the quarter pole, getting to the leader in the final yards to give his trainer and jockey their first Arlington Million victory. "It was a monster effort by a horse trained to the minute by a superb trainer, which makes my job very enjoyable," said jockey Pat Day. "When they show that much talent and courage and consistency, that's the making of a good horse," said trainer Bill Mott. "There aren't too many weak spots in his past performances." Mott indicated the five-year-old would be pointed for the D. C. International next, but a decision on his Breeders' Cup objective is still up in the air. "I think he can go a mile and a half," said Mott. "It's definitely in my mind, the way he ran today." Paradise Creek gave his sire, Irish River (Fr), his second GI win of the weekend, following in the hoofsteps of Beverly D. victress Hatoof.

Catching a dry track for the first time in his short career, Wild Escapade was overlooked as the longest shot on the board but came from just behind pacesetter Boone's Mill to stride home five lengths the best under jockey Jorge Chavez. The two-year-old was making his stakes debut after finishing last in a four-horse allowance field last time out. "We thought that race was so bad, we threw it out," said trainer Leo O'Brien. "We thought that a non-winners of one race would be better for him, but (stakes coordinator) Mike Lakow talked us into running. You just never know in this game."

Flanders (Seeking the Gold), a 7 1/2-length maiden winner in her career opener at Saratoga August 10, makes the jump to Grade I stakes competition. "It is a big step for her to run in this race, but she acts like she is of that quality," said Todd Pletcher, assistant to trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "Some other fillies in the race have more experience than her, but she's an extremely professional filly and has her mind on business." She will have her work cut out for her, facing the undefeated **Stormy Blues** (Cure the Blues); a runaway winner in her debut at Belmont, she came back in the Gill Sorority S. at Monmouth and closed from fifth to best the well-regarded **Cat Appeal** by nine.

BELMONT PARK OPENS FRIDAY New York racing returns to Belmont Park Friday, September 2 for the 40-day Fall Championship meet. Two nationally televised cards, Super Saturday, September 17, (ESPN, 4:00-5:00 p.m. EDT) and Breeders' Cup Preview Day, October 8, (NBC, 4:00-6:00 p.m. EDT), will highlight the meeting. Super Saturday will feature six Grade I races: the Futurity (two-year-olds), Matron (two-year-old fillies), Vosburgh (sprinters), Ruffian H. (fillies and mares), Man o'War (turf) and the nine-furlong Woodward for three-year-olds and up. Breeders' Cup Preview Day will showcase Breeders' Cup hopefuls in the Kelso H. (Mile), Moet Champagne (Juvenile), Frizette (Juvenile Fillies) and Jockey Club Gold Cup (Classic). The first New York Showcase, a seven-race event for New York-bred and sired horses, will be held Saturday, October 15. Racing at Belmont will be held six days a week, with Mondays (excepting Labor Day and closing day) dark, and runs through October 18.

GERALD LAWRENCE OUT AT NYRA Citing political differences, New York Racing Association Executive Vice President Gerald Lawrence announced his resignation, effective today. "Because of differences I have had with the leadership of the NYRA I regret to announce that I have decided to resign," said Lawrence in a prepared statement Sunday.
