**ATTENDANCE, HANDLE DOWN AT EXPANDED SARATOGA MEET** On-track attendance fell 11.6 percent and on-track handle was off 13.9 percent at the 34-day Saratoga meeting which concluded yesterday. Average daily on-track handle fell from \$3,742,773 during the 30-day meet in 1993 to \$3,222,460 in '94. On-track attendance slipped from last year's 26,177 to 23,160. Total daily average handle was off 2.3 percent, from \$10,752,700 to \$10,512,190. "Those numbers are not startling based on history," said NYRA President Jerry McKeon. "When we expanded the meet from four to five weeks in 1991, attendance dropped 12 percent and handle 11 percent. When you factor in that we have had only 15 days of fast tracks, seven days of firm turf course, over a foot of rain and 32 races taken off the turf, attendance and handle figure to be a little softer. And we shouldn't forget that the total daily average handle of over \$10.5 million is the highest in the country. I firmly believe that we have an excellent base on which to build the five-and-one-half week meet both next year and in the future." The Saratoga jockey title was captured by Jerry Bailey, who took his first jockey's crown at the Spa with 38 wins; trainer Shug McGaughey, who saddled 15 winners at the meet, also wrapped up his first Saratoga title.

**ARLINGTON SETS ILLINOIS WAGERING RECORD** The total handle on Sunday's Arlington Million Day card at Arlington International Racecourse, \$13,342,166, established a new record for wagering in the state of Illinois. The previous record, \$8,176,055, was set November 6, 1993 at Hawthorne Racecourse on the Breeder's Cup card. A total of \$22,367,460 was wagered on the two-day International Festival of Racing at Arlington.

A wire-to-wire maiden winner in her debut at Saratoga August 10, Flanders stepped right into GI company and made it two-for-two. The speedy filly sprinted to a clear lead early through rapid fractions of :21 4/5 and :44 4/5, showing the way by a length and a half after a half; she increased the margin through the final three furlongs to cross the line 4 3/4 in front under jockey Pat Day. It was the fifth Spinaway victory for trainer D. Wayne Lukas, but the first for owner/breeder William T. Young. Previously undefeated favorite Stormy Blues stalked the leader but could not menace in the stretch drive, losing the place spot in the final yards to late-running Sea Breezer, who broke her maiden at third asking last out. SEEKING REGINA (Seeking the Gold), winner of the GII Adirondack S., moved into second at the half but tired from her early efforts and faded to fifth.
