HAYDOCK FIELD SET **Blue Siren** (Bluebird) and **Piccolo** (Warning), who finished first and second in the Keeneland Nunthorpe S. but had their placings reversed by York stewards, are set to renew their rivalry in this Saturday's Haydock Sprint Cup. The additional eight five-day acceptors for the six-furlongs, G1 event are: **Blyton Lad** (Skyliner), **Lavinia Fontana** (Sharpo), **Owington** (Green Desert), **Risky** (Risk Me), **Stack Rock** (Ballad Rock), **Tabook** (Cadeaux Genereux), **Unblest** (Alzao) and **Zieten** (Danzig). **Dolphin Street** (Bluebird), runner-up to Owington in the July Cup at Newmarket, had also been expected to take part but will miss the race due to a foot injury. He will now be pointed to Longchamp's Oct. 19 Prix de la Foret before a scheduled trip to the Nov. 5 Breeders' Cup Mile.

JOCKEY CLUB RELEASES 1992 BREEDING STATISTICS The Jockey Club yesterday released breeding statistics on 6,858 Thoroughbred stallions reported as having covered 65,759 mares in 1992. These coverings resulted in 40,452 foals of 1993. The figures indicate an overall average live foal percentage of 61, a slight increase over the 60.6 percent of the previous breeding season. The number of stallions decreased by 6.4 percent from the 7,330 reported in 1991. There was also a 6.1 percent decline from the 70,011 mares reported bred in 1991. Thoroughbred breeding activity in Kentucky outstripped all other regions, with 14,762 mares producing 10,508 live foals. Remaining states on the top ten breeding activity list were: California, Florida, Texas, Oklahoma, Louisiana, Maryland, Washington, New York and Illinois. The 1992 statistics include progeny sired by stallions standing in North America but foaled abroad, as reported by foreign Stud Book authorities.

NAMES BOOK NOW AVAILABLE FROM JOCKEY CLUB The Jockey Club advises that the 1994 edition of Registered Thoroughbred Names is now available. The Names Book is a valuable means of assistance to owners and breeders in selecting appropriate names for their Thoroughbreds. Published annually, the book contains more than 560,000 names active at the time of publication.

Monday, Del Mar
DEL MAR DERBY-GII, \$300,000, 3yo, 9fT
Triple Crown participants **Numerous** (Mr. Prospector) and **Powis Castle** (Rare Brick) both took their turf debuts in their most recent outings July 27 at Del Mar. Powis Castle ran away with the mile-long Oceanside S., while Numerous scored in an allowance at the same distance on the stake's undercard. In all, ten three-year-olds have been invited to the 50th running of the Del Mar Derby. They are: **Blue Grass Prince** (IRE) (Bluebird), **Eagle Eyed** (Danzig), **Fumo di Londra** (IRE) (Indian Ridge {IRE}), **Marvin's Faith** (IRE) (Sharp Victor), Numerous, Powis Castle, **Pollock's Luck** (Polish Navy), **Soul of the Matter** (Private Terms), **Unfinished Symph** (Aloha Prospector) and **You and I** (Kris S.). Saturday, September 3, the morning of entries for the Derby, provisional invitees will be published. The provisional horses will gain spots in the race should any of the original invitees decide not to run.

Monday, Philadelphia Park
PENNSYLVANIA DERBY-GII, \$200,000, 3yo, 9f
A field of 12 runners is shaping up for the Labor Day event. Hailing from the barn of two-time Pennsylvania Derby winner Richard Small, **Concern** (Broad Brush) came within a neck of upsetting Holy Bull in the GI Travers in his last start. Previously, the colt won the GII Arkansas Derby and placed third in the Preakness and Haskell. **Meadow Flight** (Meadowlake) has captured two stakes this season, the GIII Flamingo and the Long Branch at Monmouth. In his last effort, he finished second to Holy Bull in the Haskell. **Kandaly** (Alydar) has also been tested against the best in his division, winning the Louisiana Derby in only his fourth career start, then finishing fourth in both the Blue Grass and Preakness. Other probables include **Signal Tap** (Fappiano), **Looming** (Broad Brush), **Alleged Impression** (Sitzmark), **Red Tazz** (Stalwart), **Love Song** (Private Terms), **Sinceilostmybaby** (Lost Code), **Richie the Coach** (Maudlin), **He'd Better Fire** (Better Arbitor) and **Hold My Tongue** (Gate Dancer).
