Three stakes have been moved from Belmont to Aqueduct: the \$150,000 Top Flight H., to be run November 25; the \$100,000a Red Smith H., set for November 19; and the \$100,000a Fall Highweight H., to be run Thanksgiving Day, November 24. The Aqueduct Fall Meet runs from October 18 through December 31.

"I was a little skeptical earlier this month that this new turf course would be ready in time to race over this early," said winning trainer Roger Attfield. Last for three-quarters of a mile, Shir Dar and jockey Corey Nakatani made their move in the stretch, rallying between horses and catching the early leader, longshot Baby Diamonds, in the final yards. NYTB PROPOSES MARE RESIDENCY RULE

The Board of the New York Thoroughbred Breeders, Inc. has unanimously approved recommendations for a regulation concerning residency requirements for both "Resident" and "Visiting" broodmares. NYTB will recommend that, except for foals of 1995, a broodmare must be a resident of New York within 90 days of her last cover in the year of conception in order for the foal of that mating to be a registered New York-bred; it will also recommend that the 90-day after-last-cover be waived for foals of 1995--mares will have to establish residency by October 15, 1994 in order to avoid the breed-back requirement. A broodmare which has not met either guideline would be considered a visiting mare, and must foal in New York, be bred back to a registered New York stallion and remain in the state for 90 days after foaling in order for her foal to be a registered New York-bred. The recommendations will now have to be approved by the Board of the reconstituted New York State Thoroughbred Breeding and Development Fund, which was enlarged to 11 members from five. The Fund board cannot meet, however, until one or more of the new appointments is made, as a quorum now constitutes six members. Governor Mario Cuomo announced that he would appoint NYTB President Douglas B. Koch, DVM, to the Fund board, but the appointment has not been made official, and none of the other five appointees have been named.

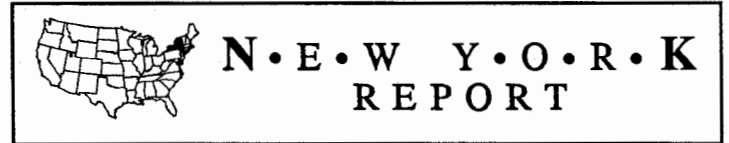
