**KEENELAND SEPTEMBER YEARLING SALE HOLDING STEADY IN FIRST SESSION** A total of 288 head were sold in yesterday's opening session of the Keeneland September Yearling Sale, which runs through September 21. The gross for the first day of the sale was \$24,494,000 for an average of \$85,049, closely mirroring the \$23,213,00 grossed for 272 yearlings during the opener of the '93 auction. The session topper was a filly by Capote out of the MSW Great Lady M. purchased for \$535,000 by R. W. Mulhall, agent; the bay, consigned by Taylor Made Sales Agency as agent for Joseph and William Stavola, Inc., is a half-sister to Horse of the Year Lady's Secret (Secretariat) and SW Missy Slew (Seattle Slew).

**HALL OF FAME JOCKEYS HONORED IN PANAMA** Many of America's top jockeys will be in South America this weekend as part of Panama's Festival de Estrellas Hipicas (Festival of Racing Stars), honoring Hall of Famers Laffit Pincay Jr. and Jorge Velasquez. The two riders will be presented with the country's most prestigious sports award, the Manuel Roy Medal. Fellow Panamanians Jacinto Vasquez, Alex Solis and Martin Pedroza will be on hand, as well as Americans Gary Stevens, Kent Desormeaux, Chris Antley, Walter Guerra and Corey Nakatani. All of the riders, with the exception of Velasquez, who is currently on the sidelines, will ride in Sunday's 10-race card at the Hipodromo Presidente Remon in Panama City. The feature will be the Clasico Cerveza Panama; after the race, Panama's President Ernesto Perez Balladaros will present Pincay with the key to the country. As many as 30 American racetracks will simulcast the Clasico Cerveza Panama.

**BROCCO TO MISS SUPER DERBY** Three-year-old Brocco (Kris S.), who was a disappointing sixth in Sunday's Del Mar Budweiser Breeders' Cup H. in his first start since finishing fourth in the Kentucky Derby, came out of the race in good order but will not make his next start in the Super Derby. "He came out of the race okay, but I don't think he got enough out of it," said trainer Randy Winick. "We're not going to make any long-term plans with this horse now; the Super Derby in three weeks is out." News cont. p2

**Saturday, Belmont**

**GI \$500,000 Woodward S., 3yo/up, 9f**

Eight Grade I winners are expected for the highlight of Belmont Park's Super Saturday card. **Devil His Due** (Devil's Bag) is scheduled to start just three more times before heading to a new career at stud. Trainer Allen Jerkens is looking at the Woodward, the Jockey Club Gold Cup and the Breeders' Cup Classic. Last year's Woodward winning trainer Bobby Frankel will try to take two in a row, this time with Pacific Classic winner **Tinners Way** (Secretariat), who is booked on a plane for New York Thursday. Travers winner **Holy Bull** (Great Above) will ship to New York from Monmouth Park Saturday morning. "He's just perfect," said owner/trainer Jimmy Croll. "He's right on schedule and he should run good. There will be no excuses." Also pointing for the race are the winners of the '93 and '94 Whitney H., **Brunswick** (Private Account) and **Colonial Affair** (Pleasant Colony), respectively; last year's Woodward winner **Bertrando** (Skywalker); Derby victor **Go for Gin** (Cormorant); and **Pistols and Roses** (Darn That Alarm).

**Saturday, Belmont**

**GI \$400,000 Man o'War S., 3yo/up, 11fT**

Veteran turf star **Fraise** (Strawberry Road {Aus}) heads the list of probables for the Man o'War. The six-year-old last visited the winner's circle following the GI Pan American at Gulfstream last March; he was fourth in the GI Sword Dancer last out. Three-year-old **Run Softly** (Deputy Minister) will make his American debut looking for his first stakes win. The colt was trained by Barry Hills in England but will be under the care of Bobby Frankel in the States. "He'll be a useful horse in America," said Hills. "He should have a good future over there." Tony Margotta will saddle **Turk Passer** (Turkoman) for the race. "He's better now than he's ever been. He's in a whole new zone," said Margotta of the GI Bowling Green victor.

Champion Phone Chatter, making only her second start since winning last year's Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, made up some ground in the lane but could not get past the winner.

**MAIDEN WINS BIG AT FINGER LAKES** She might not be Secretariat, but when **Honey By The Sea** (Seattle Song) decided to break her maiden in her 23rd career start, she did it by a wider margin than Big Red in his Belmont S. romp. The four-year-old filly, who had lost her last two by a combined 38 1/2 lengths while being backed down to 5-2 both times, was sent off the 8-5 choice in the fourth race at Finger Lakes yesterday, a mile-and-seventy yard event for maiden claimers; going right to the front, she was 18 on top after three-quarters and came under the wire 39 lengths ahead of the runner-up. "They scraped the rail (Sunday) so speed was doing real good (Monday)," said Daily Racing Form trackman Matt Church as he searched for an explanation for the performance. "The horse just kept opening up. The kid (jockey David Miller) kept hitting her through the stretch--he probably hit her 15 to 20 times."
