**BALANCHINE TO RACE AGAIN** Balanchine (Storm Bird), the dual Classic winner who needed emergency surgery for a life-threatening attack of colic earlier this year, looks set to return to the racecourse next season. Arrangements have been made for the three-year-old filly, successful in both the Epsom Oaks and Budweiser Irish Derby, to spend her second consecutive winter in Dubai; she is expected to fly back to Britain in the spring for another European campaign. Simon Crisford, manager of owner Sheikh Mohammed's Godolphin racing operation, said, "Balanchine has made a complete recovery from her operation and all that can be said is that the signs are very encouraging for next year. There is a strong possibility that she will go back into training."

**SUPER SATURDAY NOTES** Devil His Due (Devil's Bag) had his final tune-up for the Woodward yesterday morning, going five furlongs on the Belmont training track in 1:00.24. The five-year-old galloped out three-quarters in 1:13.57. "He galloped out strong--he won't have any excuses as far as that," said his trainer, Allen Jerkens. Holy Bull (Great Above) is scheduled to blow out for the race Friday. "He's doing real good," said Bob Coffey, assistant to owner/trainer Jimmy Croll. "He's trying to kick the barn down." Man o'War runner Fraise (Strawberry Road {Aus}) worked a half-mile in :49.82 Wednesday morning. Three Super Saturday invaders have arrived in New York. Flag Down (Deputy Minister), winner of the Gill La Coupe S., shipped in to Aqueduct's quarantine barn Tuesday evening; the four-year-old will blow out for the Man o'War S. Friday at Belmont. Woodward runners Bertrando (Skywalker) and Tinnors Way (Secretariat) were bedded down at their Belmont barns yesterday afternoon after flying in from California; Bertrando zipped a half-mile in :46 2/5 at Del Mar Tuesday.

Betting favorite On Target, making only his 2nd lifetime appearance, raced in 6th until the turn for home, where he made up ground for the victory. "It was a lot of fun," said winning trainer Ron McAnally. "We've always had a lot of confidence in him. He (owner Verne Winchell) even had enough confidence to buy his full brother yesterday (at Keeneland) for \$625,000." Supremo held the lead briefly at the top of the stretch before being outfinished by the winner. "I found myself on the lead and he wasn't ready to be there," said jockey Gary Stevens. "But he's got talent. I think he'll be a nice one." Gill winner Timber Country, well back in the early stages, finished strongly for 3rd. "He's a big strider and he eats up that ground," said his jockey Corey Nakatani. "He ran out of room today, but he'll be there when those longer races come around." On Target is a half-brother to Paper Princess (MSW, \$383,400, by Flying Paster) and Sea Cadet (MGI, \$1,747,650, by Bolger).

**KEENELAND'S THIRD SESSION SHOWS**

**GAINS** A son of Triple Crown winner Seattle Slew brought top price of \$350,000 during Wednesday's third session of Keeneland's 10-day September Yearling Sale. John A. Toffan of West Vancouver, British Columbia bought the dark bay or brown colt. Out of Confirm, by Proudest Roman, the session topper is a half-brother to five stakes winners. Second highest price of \$220,000 was paid by Gooree Stud of New South Wales, Australia for a bay colt from the first crop of Wood Memorial winner Cahill Road. The colt, out of Crystal Goddess, by Dr. Fager, was consigned by Taylor Made Sales Agency, agent for Kenneth Schlich's Winsome Farm Inc., and is a half-brother to GIII winner Rabiadella (Dynaformer). There were 312 horses sold yesterday for \$14,821,500, an average of \$47,505. This represents a remarkable 27 percent increase over last year's third session, when 327 yearlings brought \$12,218,700, averaging \$37,366. The sale continues through September 21.

**PHONE CHATTER RIGHT ON SCHEDULE**

Herman Sarkowsky's 1993 Eclipse winner **Phone Chatter** (Phone Trick) had her second start this year in Monday's Vielle Vigne H. at Del Mar, in which she finished second. "She stepped on herself a little and tore her quarter off a bit," said trainer Richard Mandella. "I might have babied her a little too much between races, but I'm sure the race helped her." The trainer noted that he plans to start the three-year-old filly once more prior to the November 5 Breeders' Cup. That start could come in either the Lady's Secret at Santa Anita Oct. 10 or the Spinster S. at Keeneland Oct. 16. Mandella seemed to indicate he would be more likely to go in the California race. Chris Baker, Mandella's assistant, reported yesterday that Phone Chatter is in good condition after her race and the quarter-crack injury turned out to be minor.
