HOLLYWOOD POSTS RECORDS FOR DEL MAR INTER-TRACK MEET The new Hollywood Park Casino helped generate record handle and attendance figures for the inter-track meeting at Hollywood Park during the recently concluded Del Mar meet. Handle for the meet was up 17.6 percent, while attendance rose 10.6 percent over 1993 for the 43-day stand. Hollywood Park became the leading satellite site for the Del Mar meet with an average daily handle of \$1,308,921, an increase of more than \$196,112 from last year. "We were very pleased with the results," said R.D. Hubbard, Hollywood's CEO. "It's clear horse racing and the Hollywood Park Casino are compatible."

SPONSORS FOR NEW YORK SHOWCASE Two mainstays of the New York breeding industry, Akindale Training Center and the Sugar Maple Stallions, have each agreed to participate in Belmont Park's New York Showcase by sponsoring the stakes for two-year-olds on the all New York-bred card, which is set for Saturday, October 15. Akindale will sponsor the Maid of the Mist S. for fillies, and Sugar Maple Stallions will sponsor the Sleepy Hollow S. for colts and geldings. Sponsorship for the races, sought by the New York Thoroughbred Breeders, Inc., will underwrite the cost of the live, 90-minute telecast of the Showcase on Sportschannel. Gallagher's Steak House in Manhattan had already joined as sponsor for the Empire Classic, and New York Tourism's "I Love New York" campaign will also take part.

Jerry Brown's Thoro-Graph Analysis:

As usual, the Woodward levels the playing field. Contested over a one-turn course under weight-for-age conditions, no one enjoys an advantage, which makes this a straightforward exercise in performance-figure and form-cycle handicapping.

Tinners Way, Colonial Affair and Devil His Due, are all coming off maximum efforts that figure to set them back. Devil His Due ran a Thoro-Graph figure of zero while losing the Whitney. He earned a much better rating than winner Colonial Affair because he was spotting that one eight pounds. The last time the Devil ran a zero was in the Brooklyn; he bounced in the Suburban, barely winning against a weak field. He should bounce again, and this field is not weak.

All of which means this race probably comes down to two top three-year-olds. Holy Bull has run mostly big races in a strenuous campaign that has been going on uninterrupted since the dead of winter. His best race will probably win this, but with every start he makes without taking a break, his chances of throwing in a bad one increase. Holy Bull is the best horse, but a shaky proposition at a short price.

We stated in this space about a month ago that Go for Gin was the most likely winner of the Breeders' Cup Classic, and we still feel that way. Nick Zito is doing everything right, and the summer vacation was a key move. He will certainly move forward Saturday, and the only question is whether he's still a race away from a huge effort. At 7-2 or higher, we'll pay to find out. *Thoro-Graph sheets, state-of-the-art performance figures, are used by many industry professionals to evaluate the ability of racehorses. UNBRIDLED COLT TOPS FRIDAY'S SESSION

AT KEENELAND A colt by Kentucky Derby winner Unbridled out of Damask Cheek (Damascus) brought a top price of \$195,000 during Friday's session of Keeneland's September Yearling Sale. Monty Roberts, as agent, bought the half-brother to GISW Super Abound, which was consigned by Taylor Made Sales Agency. Keeneland sold 297 horses for \$9,024,900 Friday for an average of \$30,387; the average was up 34 percent from the same day last year. At the half-way point of the 10-day sale, 1,498 yearlings have sold for \$85,437,400, an average of \$57,034. That figure is 13 percent higher than the average of \$50,414 for the 1,481 horses sold at the same point in '93. The sale continues through Wednesday.

A # will distinguish first-time stakes-winners, a @ will indicate first-time graded stakes-winners and a + will denote winners who are first-time starters.
