"With her carrying 130 lbs., I didn't want to get into a position where I'd have to check and force her to regain her momentum." Smith cruised up alongside Edicated Risk (Mr. Prospector), sat chilly to the top of the stretch, then called on the filly and got all he could ask for, besting GI winner Dispute (Danzig) by 1 1/4 lengths at the wire while giving her 13 lbs. "We were forced to run the whole way, but that's Sky Beauty's game," said jockey Mike Smith. "She wants to be in the clear, and just keeps on running."

**GROSS SALE RECORD SET AT KEENELAND**

A September yearling sale record for gross sales was set Saturday with four days remaining in the 10-day auction at Keeneland. Sales totaled \$91,520,600 at the conclusion of Saturday's sixth session, topping the previous record of \$87,710,100 set during last year's nine-day auction. To date this year, Keeneland has sold 1,800 horses for an average of \$50,845. At this point in the 1993 sale, 1,797 yearlings had been sold for \$80,090,100, an average of \$44,569. Top price Saturday was \$80,000, paid by Kenneth L. Ramsey for a colt by Farma Way--Bridle Cup, by Raise A Cup. Judy Klosterman, agent for Linda Edwards, sold the half-brother to stakes winner Go Go Bride. In all, 302 horses sold Saturday for \$6,083,200, an average of \$20,143. At the comparable session last year, 316 horses brought \$5,427,300, an average of \$17,175. The sale continues through Wednesday.
