## HOLY BULL TO STAND AT JONABELL

Jimmy Croll, owner/trainer of Woodward winner **Holy Bull** (Great Above), reported yesterday that plans to sell a 25 percent interest in his stable star to Jonabell Farm of Lexington, Kentucky should be finalized in the next few days. Jonabell's purchase would be for breeding purposes only and would not take effect until the colt is retired, which is expected to be at the end of 1995. While declining to disclose the purchase price, Croll said, "He's going to stand at Jonabell. They're nice people and I'm very comfortable with them. We're very close to wrapping up the deal; it's practically all done. I'm offering them a quarter interest and I think they're looking for some investors. They're actually getting a bargain, I believe. I know I could get more money, but that's not the only thing that matters." Jonabell also stands **Housebuster**, another champion trained by Croll. **Holy Bull**, a virtual certainty to be named 1994's Horse of the Year, came out of yesterday's Woodward in good order. "He got home fine," said Croll from his barn at Monmouth Park. "He has very good recuperative powers." The three-year-old will ship to Keeneland at the end of the month. According to Croll, he will be pointed to the GI Donn H. at Gulfstream Feb. 11 as his season opener; the Hall of Famer also listed the Met Mile and Pimlico Special as possible for '95.

**SUPER SATURDAY WRAP-UP** Man o'War winner **Royal Mountain Inn** (Vigors), who is expected to make his next start in the GI Turf Classic Oct. 8, Breeders' Cup Preview Day at Belmont, came back from yesterday's race in fine fettle. "He went into the race really well, and when they do that, they tend to come out even better," said trainer Barclay Tagg. The two Team Lukas winners on Super Saturday, Matron heroine **Flanders** (Seeking the Gold) and Vosburgh victor **Harlan** (Storm Cat) are also doing well. "Flanders is definite for the Frizette (Oct. 8) and Harlan is possible for the Boojum (Oct. 9)," said assistant trainer Todd Pletcher. Matron runner-up **Stormy Blues** (Cure the Blues) will also be back for the Frizette. While **Holy Bull** is resting, the next three finishers in the Woodward, **Devil His Due** (Devil's Bag), **Colonial Affair** (Pleasant Colony) and **Go for Gin** (Cormorant) will be back for the Jockey Club Gold Cup on Preview Day.

Coming off a solid third-place finish against older horses in the GI Pacific Classic, **Dramatic Gold** was sent off the 3-1 second choice. Just off the pace for three-quarters, the colt made his move to the lead going into the far turn and had four on the field at the top of the stretch; he held on to win by a comfortable length and a half over **Bruce's Mill**, who raced in second for the entire race. The 2-1 favorite in the field of 11, **Concern** made his patented late run from last but did not threaten the top two. **Queens Plate** victor **BASQUEIAN** (Bounding Basque), part of an entry sent off at 8-1, was fifth. "I think he would have preferred a lot less dirt hitting him," said his jockey, Jack Lauzon. "He ran his race, but there were some nice horses in there." **Jim Dandy** winner **UNACCOUNTED FOR** (Private Account), the third choice, showed little finishing ninth.

Looking for his third graded stakes win, Pennine Ridge was allowed to set his own pace on a clear lead and had no trouble holding it all the way to the wire, winning as much the best under jockey John Velazquez. "Nobody wanted to be on the lead, so I went," said Velazquez. "The pace was pretty slow, and at the three-eighths pole, I knew I had it. My horse was picking it up by himself...when I asked him to go, he got right down to business." Trainer Dave Donk said he would point his colt to the Laurel Turf Cup October 16.

**SUPER SATURDAY NUMBERS UP** Saturday's total handle of \$15,461,442.67 was a Belmont Park record excluding Belmont Stakes or Breeders' Cup Days. The previous mark was \$11,691,308, set on Breeders' Cup Preview Day in 1992. The attendance for this year's Super Saturday, 25,956, was 25 percent higher than last year's crowd of 20,825; total handle was up 33 percent over the '93 figure of \$11,654,215.

**VINTAGE CROP CONFIRMED FOR**

**MELBOURNE CUP Vintage Crop** (Rousillon), whose win in Saturday's GI Jefferson Smurfit Memorial Irish St. Leger made him the first horse ever to take the same Classic twice, is now on target to try for back-to-back victories in the Melbourne Cup. Trainer Dermot Weld said after the seven-year-old's success at The Curragh, "The next phase is to go for a second Melbourne Cup November 2. He has put up a superb performance here and will go into quarantine straight away so that I can have an extra week with him in Australia. Last year I always thought I cut it a bit fine and another few days should help his chance. However, he has a tough assignment out there with 10 pounds more than he carried last season."

**MEADOWLAKE FILLY TOPS BIDDING AT**

**KEENELAND SUNDAY** Mike Pegram paid a top price of \$100,000 for a filly by Meadowlake--Ashley's Miss (Big Bluffer) during Sunday's session of Keeneland's September Yearling Sale. Consigned by Wooden Shoe Farm, Inc., as agent, she is a half-sister to SW Sophia's Choice. Keeneland sold 297 horses for \$5,148,600 Sunday, an average of \$17,335, up 23 percent over the average for the same session in '93 when 253 yearlings went for \$3,561,300, averaging \$14,076. The average for the first seven days of the 10-day auction is \$46,099, an increase of nearly 13 percent over last year.
