BIEN BIEN TO STAND AT MILL RIDGE

FARM Trudy McCaffery and John Toffan, owners of \$2,331,875-earner and four-time Grade I winner **Bien Bien** (Manila), announced yesterday that the five-year-old chestnut will stand the 1995 breeding season at Mill Ridge Farm in Lexington, Kentucky. **Bien Bien** returned to Santa Anita yesterday after undergoing surgery for a lateral condylar fracture of the right fore cannon bone, suffered during a breeze Saturday at Santa Anita. Dr. Doug Herthel and Dr. Greg Ferraro used two screws to repair the fracture. After a 30-day let down at the track, **Bien Bien** will spend 30 days at McCaffery and Toffan's Bradbury, California farm before shipping to Kentucky. He will stand for \$15,000 live foal as the property of McCaffery and Toffan.

RECORD-BREAKING KEENELAND SALE

CONCLUDES Keeneland's 1994 September Yearling Sale ended Wednesday with new records for gross sales and average. Sales totaled \$104,709,900 for the 10-day auction, topping the previous mark of \$87,710,100 set last year. The average, \$37,171, was 5.7 percent higher than the previous mark of \$35,168, also set a year ago. Keeneland sold 2,817 horses, second to the 2,913 head sold in 1990. Top price at yesterday's final session was \$30,000, paid by William L. Meredith for a chestnut filly by Yes I'm Blue--Soft Power (Lines of Power). Viking Farm, as agent, sold the filly, named Soft Blue. There were 233 yearlings sold Wednesday for a total of \$1,652,400 and an average of \$7,092.

SAYYEDATI GOES STRAIGHT TO

BREEDERS' CUP Sayyedati (Shadeed), one of the nine five-day entrants for Saturday's G1 Queen Elizabeth S. II at Ascot, will miss the event in favor of a crack at the Breeders' Cup Mile. Trainer Clive Brittain said, "The (soft) ground at Ascot would be against her and I wouldn't want to take the edge off her. She is very well, though, and will be aimed at the Breeders' Cup Mile this year, not the Sprint."

PEGASUS H.-GII, \$200,000, 3yo, 9f

A dozen three-year-olds, headed by the Sonny Hine-trained **Red Tazz** (Stalwart), have been entered. **Red Tazz**, runner-up to Meadow Flight in the Pennsylvania Derby, has been installed as the 5-2 morning line favorite. Second choice at 9-2 is **Richie The Coach** (Maudlin), who won two straight in Maryland before setting the early pace in the Pennsylvania Derby and finishing fifth. Kent Desormeaux will fly in from the West Coast to ride **Hello Chicago** (Broad Brush), who has won three of his last four starts at Santa Anita, Hollywood and Del Mar. He is listed at 8-1 on the morning line. KENTUCKY CUP JUVENILE S.-GIII, \$80,000, 2yo, 1 1/16m

Cure the Jinx (Cure the Blues), a maiden winner over a sloppy Calder track in June and fourth in the Sept. 3 Ellis Park Juvenile, breezed a half-mile at Turfway Wed. in :49 3/5. **Hyroglyphic** (High Brite), the probable favorite after his victories in the GIII Bashford Manor S. and the Ellis Park Juvenile, galloped at Churchill Downs yesterday. Trainer James Keefer said the gelding, who has earned \$159,215 to date, will probably blow out a slow half-mile Thursday morning. Other candidates for the race, formerly known as the Alysheba, are **Artic Explosion** (Eskimo), **Bick** (Manila), **Gold Miner** (Gold Crest), **One Mean Man** (Lively One), **Tejano Run** (Tejano) and **Z Lobo** (Key to the Mint).
