ABC SPORTS REACHES TRIPLE CROWN

AGREEMENT ABC Sports has reached a new multi-year agreement which will extend into the next decade the network's coverage of the Triple Crown, it was announced yesterday by Dennis Swanson, president of ABC Sports; Thomas Meeker, president of Churchill Downs; Joe De Francis, president and CEO of the Maryland Jockey Club; and Gerard McKeon, president of the New York Racing Association. In addition to the Triple Crown races, ABC will broadcast the Florida Derby, Santa Anita H., Santa Anita Derby, Pimlico Special, Wood Memorial, Derby Trial, Kentucky Oaks and Travers. All races will be telecast on Wide World of Sports. As part of the Triple Crown agreement, ABC Sports has acquired the rights to package the Triple Crown for television. The network will provide marketing and promotional opportunities for sponsors, including hospitality, event tickets and on-site exposure.

TWO PUNCH TO REMAIN IN MARYLAND

Windfields Farm, Ross Valley Farm and Eleanor Ross, and Northview Stallion Station jointly announced yesterday that they have reached an agreement in principle to settle their differences over the stallion **Two Punch** (Mr. Prospector). The settlement agreement contemplates that the current owners of Two Punch--Windfields Farm, Ross Valley Farm and Ms. Ross--will sell the stallion to Northview and that Northview will continue to stand the horse at its Chesapeake City, Maryland facility. The settlement also contemplates that Windfields, Ross Valley and Ms. Ross will retain certain breeding interests in the stallion and that the pending litigation will be dismissed.

BINALONG TO MILL RIDGE Binalong (Known Fact), a three-time stakes-winner who set a track record for seven furlongs at Keeneland, has been retired and will stand the 1995 season at Mill Ridge Farm in Lexington, Kentucky. The five-year-old had won both his '94 starts, the Hallandale H. and the Olympic H., in which he set a stakes record. A winner of \$321,876, he will stand for a fee of \$5,000, live foal as property of Mill Ridge and James Tafel.

PENNEKAMP TO TAKE ON SRI PEKAN

Pennekamp (Bering {GB}), winner of Longchamp's Prix de la Salamandre 13 days ago, will have his next outing in Newmarket's G1 Generous Dewhurst S. Oct. 14. But the colt, trained by Andre Fabre for Sheikh Mohammed, will inevitably face strong opposition in what is traditionally Britain's most competitive two-year-old event. Chief among his rivals in the seven-furlong contest will be England's officially top-rated juvenile **Sri Pekan** (Red Ransom), who collected his fifth success from six career starts when taking Doncaster's G2 Laurent-Perrier Champagne S. by six lengths Sept. 10.

ROSE BOWL PUT DOWN

Rose Bowl (Habitat), winner of both the 1975 Queen Elizabeth II and Champion S., has been put down at the age of 22. The mare, who raced for Charles Engelhard before being purchased for breeding purposes by Paul Mellon, spent the last ten years of her life at Kingsclere Stud in Berkshire in the care of trainer Ian Balding and his wife Emma. **Rose Bowl**, a half-sister to 1978 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth S. hero **Ile de Bourbon**, produced ten foals of whom seven have won. Her best offspring were the Mill Reef colt **Rose Reef**, successful at the G3 level, and **Vaguely Noble's** daughter **Golden Bowl**, a winner in Listed company. Balding said, "It's terribly sad but old age caught up with her and we didn't want her to suffer."

KEENELAND'S BREEDING STOCK SALE TO FEATURE DISPERSALS

Several important dispersals will be offered on the first day of Keeneland's November Breeding Stock Sale. The sale starts Sunday, Nov. 6, one day after the Breeders' Cup at Churchill Downs. Mrs. John Hay Whitney, Loblolly Stable, Tilly Foster Farms, Thomas P. Whitney, Kennedy Northern Inc., New Haven Farm and Sandi-Hill Farm each will disperse breeding stock to begin the sale. Also on the first day, Earle Mack, John Moran and partners will dissolve a partnership that includes MGI winner **November Snow** (Storm Cat), and Darley Stud Management will offer a major consignment. The sale was extended two days through Nov. 15. Approximately 3,250 horses and stallion shares, including a record 1,400 weanlings, will be catalogued for the annual auction.
