Coming off a fourth-place finish in the GII Pennsylvania Derby, where he was beaten just a length and a quarter after being steadied in the stretch, Brass Scale staged a rally from the back of the back that gave him the lead at the top of the stretch; relishing the going in his first trip on an off track, the gelding widened through the lane to win as much the best. "He stumbled at the start and I was worried for a couple of steps," said jockey Edgar Prado. "I thought he might have cut himself or pulled a shoe, that's how bad he stumbled. After that, he started running. He did everything on his own. He's a nice colt and he's still improving." Owner Bayard Sharp remarked, "I always thought that he was a nice horse. We had intended to be up close to the pace, because they said speed had been holding up all night. I never thought he'd be that far back and still win." Added winning trainer Charlie Peoples, "Mr. Sharp is in his 80's and I'm in my 70's; we're pretty old and stiff, but a win like this helps keep us loose."
