Among the stumbling blocks in his path is stablemate **Apple Tree (Fr)** (Bikala {Ire}), who could take his chance next weekend if the ground is not too testing. Trainer Andre Fabre had originally planned to send the Coronation Cup winner straight to the Breeders' Cup, but is now considering both races. Others likely to swell the field are the first two from the St. Leger, **Moonax (Ire)** (Caerleon) and **Broadway Flyer** (Theatrical {Ire}), as well as the Italian pair of **Big Tobin (Ity)** (Big Reef {Ire}) and **Mr. Richard (Ire)** (Fools Holme). **White Muzzle (GB)** (Dancing Brave) is currently being held as the 4-1 favourite for the race.

The 2-1 choice, AGATHE (Manila), a GSW in France, made a mild middle move but hung in the final yards to finish fourth. "My filly felt like she entrapped," said her jockey, Mike Smith. "She made a lot of noise pulling up, and even more when she was galloping back...it was bothering her."
