TEAM LUKAS HORSES ON TRACK FOR BREEDERS' CUP **Tabasco Cat** (Storm Cat), winner of Saturday's inaugural Kentucky Cup Classic, came out of the race in good order and will now be pointed for the Breeders' Cup Classic. Team Lukas will also send out Kentucky Cup Juvenile Fillies winner **Cat Appeal** (Storm Cat) and Kentucky Cup Sprint third-place finisher **Chimes Band** (Dixieland Band) on Breeders' Cup Day, set for Nov. 5 at Churchill Downs.

AUSTRALIAN ILLNESS STILL A MYSTERY
One more horse has died and another is showing signs of the mystery illness that has killed eleven horses in Brisbane, Australia. The two new horses both come from trainer Vic Rail's stable, where 10 of the previous 11 dead have been stabled; the other was from an stable adjacent to Rail's. Rail himself is critically ill as well, and was admitted to Royal Brisbane Hospital Tuesday, where he remains on life-support systems. Eight additional horses continue to show signs of the illness while authorities await results of diagnostic testing to determine its source.

LOCHSONG DOUBTFUL FOR LONGCHAMP
Lochsong (Song {GB}), voted Britain's Horse of the Year in 1993, is looking unlikely to bid for her second consecutive Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp in Paris Sunday. The brilliant six-year-old sprinter, successful in four Group races this season, was described by trainer Ian Balding as "a bit doubtful" for the race. Balding added, "She had a cough last week and has had a runny nose since, so I'm not too happy that we'll have her ready in time. But we will work her and have her scoped on Wednesday before making a final decision." The mare's long-range plans could still include a bid for the Breeders' Cup Sprint.

MISTER BAILEYS INJURED Mister Baileys (Robellino), winner of the 2000 Guineas at Newmarket in April, may have run his last race. The three-year-old, due to retire to Britain's National Stud at the end of the season, was expected to have one more start, in Newmarket's Champion S. October 15, before taking up stallion duties. But the Mark Johnston-trained colt has developed a swelling on a leg which may curtail his proposed fall campaign. Said Johnston, "(The swelling) is in the same site as an injury he picked up after the Sussex S. and it looks as though he won't be ready to run in the Champion." Following his Classic victory, Mister Baileys was third in the Dante S. and fourth in the Epsom Derby; in his only other '94 outing, he finished fifth the Sussex S.
