**COUP DE GENIE RETIRED** Coup de Genie (Mr. Prospector), third behind Balanchine in this year's 1000 Guineas, has been retired. The Francois Boutin-trained filly, successful last year in both the Prix Morny and Prix de la Salamandre, has been dogged by ill health throughout her career. She broke blood vessels on her final two starts as a two-year-old, the Prix Marcel Boussac and Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, and suffered a bad attack of pleurisy immediately after her Guineas placing. In her last start, she finished a well-beaten fourth in the Prix du Pin Sept. 18.

### PIMLICO HANDLE SHOWS MAJOR GAIN

Pimlico Race Course posted an impressive 24 percent increase in handle as total wagering reached \$88,175,855 for the recently completed 44-day Summer/Fall Meet. In-state, handle was up nine percent over the '93 meet, while out-of-state totals rose more than 100 percent, jumping from \$12,141,532 last year to \$24,476,721 in '94. King Leatherbury captured his 21st trainer's title with 17 wins, while Edgar Prado led all jockeys with 59 victories. Racing returns to Laurel today, with first post at 1:05 p.m.
