ARC FIELD TAKING SHAPE With 25 horses appearing on the first forfeit list for Sunday's Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp, France, it seems certain there will need to be eliminations. A maximum of 20 will be allowed to take part and, since at least two more potential runners are expected to be supplemented for the Group 1 race by this Thursday's final deadline, seven or more could face the axe. The 25 first forfeits were: **Apple Tree (FR)** (Bikala {IRE}), **Big Tobin (ITY)** (Big Reef {IRE}), **Bright Moon** (Alysheba), **Broadway Flyer** (Theatrical {IRE}), **Carnegie (IRE)** (Sadler's Wells), **Celtic Arms (FR)** (Comrade In Arms {GB}), **Close Conflict** (High Estate {GB}), **Dancienne (FR)** (Groom Dancer), **Enjoy Plan** (Alydar), **Ezzoud (IRE)** (Last Tycoon {IRE}), **Hernando (FR)** (Niniski), **Highland Dress (GB)** (Lomond), **Intrepidity (GB)** (Sadler's Wells), **King's Theatre (IRE)** (Sadler's Wells), **Lando (GER)** (Acatenango {GER}), **Moonax (IRE)** (Caerleon), **Much Better (BRAZ)** (Baynoun {IRE}), **Only Royale (IRE)** (Caerleon), **Rainbow Dancer (FR)** (Rainbow Quest), **Richard Of York (GB)** (Rainbow Quest), **Rubhuhunish**, **Sierra Madre (FR)** (Baillamont), **Truly a Dream (IRE)** (Darshaan {GB}), **Vert Amande (FR)** (Kenmare {FR}) and **White Muzzle (GB)** (Dancing Brave). The two probable supplementary entries are the undefeated MG1 winner **Millkom (GB)** (Cyrano de Bergerac) and **Volochine (IRE)** (Soviet Star). If eliminations are required, they will be decided on career earnings.

EAST OF THE MOON TO MISS BREEDERS' CUP **East of the Moon** (Private Account), a disappointing seventh of nine in Saturday's G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot in England, will almost certainly miss the Breeders' Cup and be retired for the season. The daughter of two-time Breeders' Cup Mile champion Miesque was found to have a high temperature after she returned to France and it is now expected that she will be given a break before being brought back into training for next year. "She ran a temperature of 42 degrees Sunday night but it was normal by the next morning," said her trainer Francois Boutin. "However, there must have been something wrong even though I can't put my finger on it." East of the Moon has won three Group 1 events in France this year for earnings to date of \$695,107.

TATTERSALLS SALE STARTS ON HIGH

NOTE The 1994 Tattersalls Houghton Yearling Sale in the Park Paddocks at Newmarket began on a high note yesterday, reporting average and gross up through the first 55 hips. The highest-priced yearling of the group was a chestnut filly by Nashwan out of the stakes-winning mare Rappa Tap Tap (FR). Purchased by S.T.S for 320,000 guineas, the filly was consigned to the sale by Meon Valley Stud. The auction continues through Wednesday.

CHRB APPROVES CHARITY DONATIONS The California Horse Racing Board has approved the distribution by Del Mar Charities of \$265,000 in charity day proceeds to 11 beneficiaries, most of which (\$147,200) goes to United Way. Other recipients include the California Thoroughbred Horsemen's Foundation Inc., the Equine Research Laboratory at UC Davis, the Shoemaker Foundation and the Winners Foundation.

CANADIAN BREEDERS SALES POSTS FIRST SESSION GAINS A dark bay or brown yearling colt by Bold Executive--Dame Cornwall (Viceregal) brought top price of \$25,000 at Monday's first session of the 1994 Canadian Breeders Sales mixed sale at Woodbine. Consigned by Anderson Farms as agent, the colt was purchased by E. Leon & Sunny Acres. There were 66 head sold Monday for a gross of \$382,500 and an average of \$5,795, up 7.3 percent from last year's first session average of \$5,399. The sale concludes Tuesday.

HORSEMEN'S CHOICE YEARLING SALE

RESULTS Horsemen's Bloodstock Services held its second annual Horsemen's Choice Yearling Sale at Laurel Racecourse Monday. There were 93 yearlings sold for a total of \$516,500, an average of \$5,553.76 and a median of \$3,000. The average was down 64.8 percent from last year's inaugural sale average of \$15,776. The sales topper was a dark bay or brown colt by Allen's Prospect--Amerrico's Rainbow (Amerrico). Purchased by Jeanne V. Dance for \$50,000, the colt, named Allen's Rainbow, is a half brother to multiple stakes-winner Carnirainbow (Carnivalay) and a full to stakes-winner Rainbow Prospect.

BACK TO THE DRAWING BOARD

Jimmy Croll says it's not the money that is keeping Holy Bull out of the Breeders' Cup, and he makes a credible argument, that after ten races and nine months Holy Bull has had enough. So he said the decision was final and irrevocable and the fuss erupted. Anyway you look at it, everyone loses--the sport, the Breeders' Cup, even Holy Bull and Croll, who has had to take some tough hits from those who feel he is being unsporting and not putting racing's interests first.

This is a mess, and it never should have come to this.

It's not the money, not now. But it was. On January 1, Holy Bull was no better than the second best 3-year-old in the state of Florida behind Dehere. He was also a horse with a suspect pedigree who appeared incapable of going a mile and a quarter. If Croll had wanted to run in the Breeders' Cup he would have had to plot his schedule early, pointing Holy Bull in that direction. Faced with having to pay \$360,000 to make the horse eligible for the race, he would have been foolish to plan on the Breeders' Cup Classic at a time when it appeared that his horse did not have the proper credentials. The decision had to be made months ago and Croll did the sensible thing, pointing instead for prestigious and winnable races like the Met Mile and the Haskell, races that don't cost \$360,000 to enter.

But what if? What if the \$360,000 payment wasn't standing in his way when his plans were made months ago?

There has to be a better way. Holy Bull, the brightest star racing has produced in years, will not start in the Breeders' Cup. Paseana and Best Pal, neither of whom are eligible, will not run. Neither Montreal Red nor Cherokee Run are eligible and their owners are still mulling their next moves. What would have happened with The Wicked North if he had not been hurt? He's not eligible either.

The expressed purpose of the Breeders' Cup is to "provide racing with an unprecedented year-end championship and a grand spectacle which presents the sport to a worldwide television audience." Without Holy Bull and some of the others, clearly the Breeders' Cup will be falling short in

its attempts to reach that goal this year.

For a horse to be eligible to the Breeders' Cup, his or her stallion must be nominated. The cost is the value of one season to the horse. Then a \$500 payment must be made for each individual foal by October 15 of their weanling year. In the case of Holy Bull, the fees have been paid on his sire, Great Above, but the \$500 payment on Holy Bull himself was not made. Jimmy Croll admits that he slipped up and did not send in the money. The only other way to make an otherwise ineligible horse eligible is to pay the supplementary fees, which equal 12 percent of the purse, or higher if both the stallion and the foal have not been nominated.

The costs are prohibitive, Breeders' Cup officials argue, because if they were lower no one would pay the advance fees. The money coming in from breeders and owners in nomination fees makes up a large percentage of the \$10 million in purses paid out on Breeders' Cup Day.

"We want to make it difficult to find the easy way out," said Breeders' Cup spokesperson Jim Gluckson.

They should, but should it be that difficult? Clearly not. The Breeders' Cup has to have a Holy Bull, otherwise it's not what it's meant to be. There has to be a compromise.

If Croll wanted to go in the Breeders' Cup (remember that he passed last year as well after Holy Bull won the Futurity at Belmont), make him pay, but make him pay a reasonable amount. Having missed out nearly three years ago on a mere \$500 payment, he's never had a chance to make up for his mistake. Give an owner a chance to nominate again in the yearling year, but charge him, say, \$1,500. If they still pass, give them another chance. What if Croll could have paid \$10,000 last year to make Holy Bull eligible to the Breeders' Cup through the remainder of his career, would he have done it? If someone passes on May 1, make the supplementary fee six percent of the purse and not 12 percent.

Even if those changes aren't enacted, one other change has to be made. If an owner pays the current supplementary fees once, the horse should be eligible for the rest of its career. If that rule had been corrected both Paseana and Best Pal would likely be taking part in racing's big day this year.

It will still be a great Breeders' Cup, only it could have been better. It's time to go back to the drawing board.
