**ZOMAN BACK AT THE RACES** Zoman (Affirmed), whose stallion career at British Nation's Stud came to a halt when he was found to be infertile, looks set to make his comeback in the Prix du Rond-Point on Sunday's Arc card at Longchamp. The seven-year-old, who was the Champion Older Horse in Ireland in 1991 and winner of the G1 Prix D'Ispahan and G1 Budweiser International S. during a career which brought \$1,006,899 in prize money, has been back in training for several weeks with the intention of returning to the track for an autumn campaign. His trainer Paul Cole said, "If Zoman comes through a piece of work Thursday morning, he'll run in France. He has taken well to training again after so long off the course and seems to have retained his enthusiasm."

**TATTERSALLS HOUGHTON YEARLING SALES RESULTS** Yesterday marked the second and final session of the 1994 Tattersalls Houghton Yearling Sales at Newmarket. There were 280 yearlings sold during the two-day sale for a gross of 17,050,100 guineas and an average of 60,893 guineas, down slightly from last year's average of 61,727 guineas. The sales topper at 530,000 guineas was a chestnut filly by Woodman--Korveya (Riverman). The filly, named Quercifolia, is a full sister to Hector Protector, the Champion Two-Year-Old in Europe in 1990. Consigned to the sale by Ted Voute, agent for Gerald W. Leigh, the filly was purchased by Addison Racing Ltd.

**CHICK LANG JR. RESIGNS** Chick Lang Jr., general manager of Retama Park, the \$79 million race track under construction near San Antonio, Texas, resigned Wednesday for health reasons. Lang, who joined the Retama management team in June, was diagnosed with inoperable cancer one month later and has been receiving treatments since August. Before joining Retama, Lang was administrative director at Oaklawn Park in Hot Springs, Arkansas. He will be retained by Retama as an advisor.

**Fastness (IRE)** (Rousillon), who missed by a neck in the G1 Eddie Read H. at Del Mar, shares highweight of 116 pounds with two other Irish-bred horses--**Blues Traveller (IRE)** (Bluebird) and **Earl of Barking (IRE)** (Common Grounds {GB}). Trained by Jenine Sahadi, Fastness was caught on the wire by Approach The Bench in the 1 1/4-mile Eddie Read after having opened up a clear lead at the sixteenth pole. "I think he was two in front there," said Sahadi. "He had made a long, extended run and Approach The Bench just caught him. I thought he ran super." Corey Black has the mount. Also expected to start are **Stark South** (Dixieland Band) and **Emerald Jig** (Green Dancer). **Wharf** (Storm Bird) is still termed a "possible starter" by trainer Bobby Frankel, while **Approach The Bench (IRE)** (Law Society), **Cleante (ARG)** (Kleight) and **Firm Pledge** (Affirmed) are all considered doubtful.
