**FLANDERS TESTS POSITIVE** Undefeated two-year-old filly **Flanders** (Seeking The Gold) tested positive for the drug isoxuprine after winning the Sept. 17 Matron S. at Belmont and has been disqualified for purposes of purse distribution. Tests taken by the New York State Racing & Wagering Board revealed the presence of the drug, which is normally used to improve circulation in a horse's feet. Trainers are allowed to use it in New York up to 36 hours before a race. "I have no explanation," Lukas told the New York Daily News. "We're trying to figure out how this happened. She doesn't get any medication. She doesn't need any." Lukas was not in New York in the days leading up to the Matron. His New York string is handled by assistant Todd Pletcher. "I'm convinced that none of my people did anything wrong," Lukas continued. "Hopefully, it will show up in the split sample." Lukas said that **Dalhart** (Forty Niner), scheduled to run in an allowance today at Belmont, would be scratched as a precaution until it was determined exactly why **Flanders** tested positive.

**VELASQUEZ RETURNS TO RACING** Hall of Fame jockey Jorge Velasquez will return to racing today after missing most of the last eight months with a broken pelvis and a hairline fracture in his neck suffered in a Feb. 3 training accident at Calder. The 47-year-old journeyman attempted to make a comeback at Calder in May, bringing home four winners from 26 mounts in his shortened return. "I wasn't ready before, but I'm ready now," said Velasquez. "My goal is to get to 7,000 winners. It is a special number considering only three people--Bill Shoemaker, Laffit Pincay Jr. and Angel Cordero Jr.--have done it. After that I'm sure I will try to reach 8,000."

**MILLKOM SUPPLEMENTED TO ARC** **Millkom** (Cyranos de Bergerac) was the only supplementary entry for Sunday's Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, bringing to 23 the total number of horses looking for a spot in the starting gate. As the field will be limited to 20, three runners face elimination; they are: **Enjoy Plan** (Alydar) (21st on the list, based on prize money won), **Richard Of York** (Rainbow Quest) (22nd) and **Rainbow Dancer** (Rainbow Quest) (23rd).

**MISTER BAILEYS RETIRED** As expected, British 2000 Guineas winner **Mister Baileys** (Robellino) has been retired to Britain's National Stud. The colt had never fully recovered from an injury to his right foreleg suffered in the GI Sussex S., and recurrent swelling prematurely ended his racing career. He will stand for a fee of 6,500 guineas during his first season at stud, and is expected to cover 60 mares.

**LOCHSONG PASSES TEST** **Lochsong** (Song {GB}) will be fit to run in Sunday's Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp. The six-year-old mare was given the go-ahead following a gallop and vets' tests this week. Owner Jeff Smith said, "The show's on the road. She scoped clear after her workout and definitely runs."

**CHURCHILL APPROVES HBPA CONTRACT, \$2.9 MILLION FOR IMPROVEMENTS** The Churchill Downs Board of Directors yesterday approved \$2.9 million for capital improvements at the Sports Spectrum and Churchill Downs. Among the projects included at Churchill are the replacement of the bleachers in the Mezzanine Terrace, expansion of the frontside office area and updating the track's fire protection system. The Board also approved a three-year contract with the Kentucky Thoroughbred Association and the Kentucky division of the Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association. "The contract moves Churchill Downs closer to our goal of becoming the nation's premier racing center," said Thomas H. Meeker, president and CEO of Churchill Downs. "First, it addresses the day-to-day needs of all horsemen involved in our racing program; second, it strengthens our overnight and stakes purse programs; and third, it allows us to implement strategies for long-term growth."
