HEAVENLY PRIZE POINTS TO BELDAME

Grade I Alabama S. winner **Heavenly Prize** (Seeking the Gold) will start next in the GI Beldame S. to be run Breeders' Cup Preview Day, October 8, at Belmont Park. Because her regular rider Mike Smith is committed to **Sky Beauty** (Blushing Groom {Fr}) for the Nov. 5 Breeders' Cup Distaff, Heavenly Prize's trainer Shug McGaughey has assigned the mount in the Beldame to Pat Day, who is then expected to ride the three-year-old filly in the Breeders' Cup. Sky Beauty is scheduled to skip the Beldame and go straight to Churchill Downs for the Distaff. This marks the second time this year that a conflict of interest has caused Smith to lose a major mount. In the GI Woodward S., Smith gave up the mount on **Devil His Due** (Devil's Bag), who finished second, to ride winner **Holy Bull** (Great Above). Devil His Due's Woodward jockey, Jerry Bailey, is expected to keep the mount for the Breeders' Cup Classic.

KEENELAND MEET OPENS OCTOBER 8

Keeneland's fall meeting is set to open next Saturday, October 8 for a 16-day run. The meet is highlighted by the GI \$300,000a Spinster, scheduled for October 16, and the GI \$200,000 Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup, the closing day feature October 29. Expected for the Spinster is two-time champion mare **Paseana** (Ahmad) as well as GISW **Dispute** (Danzig). Changes on the stakes schedule include late closings for the GII \$100,000a Alcibiades and GII \$100,000a Breeders' Futurity, which will close October 12.
