CARNEGIE GIVES FABRE THIRD ARC WIN

Three-year-old **Carnegie (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) gave trainer Andre Fabre his third career win in the GI Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe yesterday, gamely holding off **Hernando (Fr)** (Niniski) to win the photo in a tight finish. Fabre, who had also saddled Arc champions **Tremolino** and **Subotica**, sent out a five-horse entry for this year's running, including third-place finisher **Apple Tree (Fr)** (Bikala {Fr}). After the race, he said, "Carnegie was not my best horse before the race, but he was the most progressive and the one with the best breeding." Carnegie is a son of the champion filly **Detroit**, who also won the Arc as a three-year-old, taking the 1980 edition over **Argument**. The trainer added that the colt would not start again this year. "I do not want to race him again this season, so he will not be going to the Breeders' Cup, but I would love to have him back for 1995." Fabre will, however, send **Intrepidity (GB)** (Sadler's Wells) for a second attempt in the Breeders' Cup Turf. The filly was 13th in the Arc, and 13th of 14 in last year's edition of the Turf. **White Muzzle (GB)** (Dancing Brave), sixth after a troubled trip in the Arc, will travel to North America for the Rothmans International at Woodbine; ridden by Yutaka Take in the Arc, the four-year-old will have a new jockey, John Reid, for his next start and will remain in training next season.

GROOM CHARGED IN SCOTT MURDER

Police have charged a 58-year-old man with the murder of Newmarket trainer Alex Scott. William Michael Clement O'Brien, chief groom at Scott's Glebe Stud, will appear in court today. He will also be indicted for threatening to kill Christopher Forster, another member of the staff on the Cambridgeshire estate. Scott's body was discovered Friday evening at 6:10 p.m.; he had been killed by a single gunshot wound to the chest. The local police launched a search which involved tracker dogs and a helicopter, and O'Brien was arrested Saturday, not far from the scene of the incident. It is believed he had earlier been arguing with Scott after the trainer decided to terminate his employment at the stud. Scott was one of Newmarket's most successful young horseman. He had saddled 164 winners in less than six years with a license.

JOCKEY INJURED AT CHARLES TOWN Apprentice jockey Coleen Bernat was seriously injured in a spill at Charles Town Sunday. Bernat, a 27-year-old native of Philadelphia, was thrown when her mount in the ninth race, **Unclemikesbigboy**, ducked in sharply at the top of the stretch and went over the inside rail. Bernat was taken to **Jefferson Memorial Hospital**; listed in serious condition, she was later transferred to **Washington Hospital Center** with internal injuries.
