CHEROKEE RUN TO BREEDERS' CUP

SPRINT Top sprinter **Cherokee Run** (Runaway Groom), winner of this year's GII De Francis Memorial Dash, will make his next start in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint. The four-year-old will have to be supplemented at a cost of \$120,000. "I think he's one of the best three-quarter's horses around," said trainer Frank Alexander of the decision to pay the fee. "I don't think he could be any worse than third, no matter who runs, and then he would earn back the money the owner has to put up. If he wins, he could be sprinter of the year...he should be sprinter of the year." The Florida-bred, third in the GI Vosburgh at seven furlongs last time out, has been on the board in all eight of his 1994 starts, seven of them against graded stakes competition. Favored in six of the eight outings, he was sent off at 16-1 in the Met Mile and finished second to Holy Bull. Alexander added the colt, who has earned nearly \$1 million to date, would not ship to Churchill until the week before the race. "He has run once over the track, and he won (taking the '93 Derby Trial). We'll get him ready here (at Belmont) and take him down cold turkey."

NAVARONE RETIRED MGISW **Navarone** (Irish River {Fr}), who had been scheduled to run in Sunday's Oak Tree Invitational at Santa Anita, has been retired after coming down with an illness that forced trainer Rodney Rash to cancel the remainder of the six-year-old's campaign. "The plan was to run him in the Invitational and the Breeders' Cup Turf and then retire him; missing this race effectively knocks him out of both races," said Rash. "I'm going to miss the old guy." Navarone won his last start, the GII Del Mar Invitational September 4; it has not yet been announced where he will stand at stud.

BREEDERS' CUP PREVIEW DAY

Saturday, Belmont Park
GI \$750,000 Jockey Club Gold Cup, 3yo/up, 10f
Flag Down (Deputy Minister), who had originally been scheduled to run in Saturday's Turf Classic, is now a possible starter in the Gold Cup. The Man o'War runner-up would be making his debut on the dirt. "At the moment, he's (trainer John Hammond) leaning towards the dirt, but he's still got an open mind about it," said assistant trainer Helen Scolah. The colt worked five furlongs over the Belmont main track Friday, going the distance in 1:01.63. "He seems to handle it great," said Scolah. "It was a bit of a culture shock for the first quarter, but then he jumped back on the bridle and worked very well." If available, jockey Cash Asmussen will be in the saddle Saturday. Trainer Nick Zito says he expects Derby winner **Go for Gin** (Cormorant) right up with the leaders in the Gold Cup. "He wants to be right there, on or close to the pace," said Zito. "I think it's safe to say that Go for Gin can outrun the field early; the question will be can he finish?" Also expected for the Gold Cup: **Colonial Affair** (Pleasant Colony), **Devil His Due** (Devil's Bag), **Pistols and Roses** (Darn That Alarm), and **Tabasco Cat** (Storm Cat).

GI \$500,000 Moet & Chandon Champagne, 2yo, 8.5f
Montreal Red (D'Accord), winner of the GI Futurity in his last start, will face the only colt who has beaten him, Hopeful victor **Wild Escapade** (Wild Again), who was third after contesting a hot early pace in the Futurity. "I think he'll run a better race this time," said trainer Leo O'Brien. "I'm very pleased with the way he is doing." The colt worked five-eighths on the Belmont training track yesterday in 1:03. **Sierra Diablo** (Conquistador Cielo) also worked for the race Monday, going the same distance on the main track in :59 3/5. The Futurity favorite finished fourth after battling on the lead early. "I didn't want to see him going head-to-head for the lead," said trainer Mark Hennig. "He'd never been on the lead before, and I didn't want to see him there. He was very tired after that race." New rider Jerry Bailey will be aboard Saturday. Two of the first three finishers from the grassy Pilgrim S. will come back on the dirt in the Champagne. Third-place **Islamabad** (Red Ransom) has yet to try the main track, while winner **Diplomatic Jet** (Roman Diplomat) is 0-for-three on the surface.

DISPUTE OVER FLORIDA RULING The Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering, yesterday issued an order which the Florida Thoroughbred Breeders' and Owners' Association says concurs with their interpretation of the Florida statute regarding purse requirements. The FTBOA had asked the Department last June for a ruling on what they contended was Gulfstream Park's underpayment of purses to the horsemen during the 1994 meet. Douglas Donn, Gulfstream president and CEO, responded to the ruling, saying, "We're still trying to assess what this means. We remain convinced that Gulfstream's position on the issue is correct. There is no doubt in my mind that the legislature never intended for additional purses to be paid unless additional money was withheld from the pool for that purpose."

ASMUSSEN RENEWS CONTRACT Jockey Cash Asmussen, second on Hernando in Sunday's Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, will be riding as first jockey for owner Stavros Niarchos again next season, thus continuing an association that dates back to 1982. Since their latest professional link-up, beginning in 1993, the two have teamed to take eight GI events.
