BROCCO SALE NEAR CERTAIN Albert and Dana Broccoli's **Brocco** (Kris S.), whose most memorable victory came in the 1993 Breeders' Cup Juvenile, has been sold and will be retired to stud at Will Farish's Lane's End Farm in Versailles, Kentucky, trainer Randy Winick said at Santa Anita Wednesday. Winick would not quote an exact sale price, but said it was "over \$2 million. They've got a deposit on the horse, and they're having a vet come by to run fertility tests and see that all that passes." Three-year-old **Brocco** retires with four wins in seven starts for earnings of \$1,003,550.

VINCENT O'BRIEN TO RETIRE Vincent O'Brien, arguably the most successful trainer of all time, has announced that he will retire at the end of this season. His career will have spanned a full 50 years, during which time he won six Epsom Derbys, three Arc de Triomphe, three Grand Nationals and four Cheltenham Gold Cups. In total, his trainees have won more than 40 Classic races as well as three Champion Hurdles, a Breeders' Cup and a Washington International. But of all the great racehorses to have passed through the 77-year-old Irish trainer's stables, none has made a greater impact than Nijinsky II, whose wins in the 1977 2000 Guineas, Epsom Derby and St Leger put him in the elite league of colts who have won the Triple Crown. Most of O'Brien's present string will be switched to his son Charles' yard on The Curragh. "Racing has been good to me," said O'Brien. "It has enabled me to pursue a career which combined work and pleasure. I have had the good fortune to have had many wonderful horses over the years and have been able assisted by the most dedicated staff."

Trainer Gary Jones will be represented by **Cafe Milano (FR)** (Irish River {FR}) in the Oak Tree Invitational. "Cafe Milano should be out of quarantine today," said Jones yesterday, adding that Eddie Delahoussaye has been named to ride. The three-year-old finished second, beaten 1/2-length, to Carnegie in the G2 Prix Eugene Adam at Saint-Cloud, France July 14. Carnegie went on to win the prestigious Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe last Sunday at Longchamp. The probable Oak Tree lineup also includes **Approach The Bench (IRE)** (Law Society), **Grand Flotilla** (Caro {IRE}), Gary Stevens, and **Sandpit (BRAZ)** (Baynoun {IRE}), Corey Nakatani. LADY'S SECRET H., \$100,000a, 3yo/up, f/m, 8.5f Exchange (Explodent), claimed for \$50,000 from her second lifetime start, has won 13 of 25 starts for more than \$900,000, but she will need to be at her best in the Lady's Secret. No less than three Breeders' Cup and Eclipse Award winners--**Hollywood Wildcat** (Kris S.), **Eliza** (Mt. Livermore) and **Phone Chatter** (Phone Trick)--are expected to go to the post. Hollywood Wildcat took last year's Lady's Secret en route to her victory in the Breeders' Cup Distaff. Phone Chatter, meanwhile, is still searching for a rider, as regular jockey Laffit Pincay Jr. elected to remain with Exchange. Also expected to run are **Dancing Mirage** (Alleged) and **Pub River (ARG)** (Riverside Sam).

Sam-Son Farm's two-year-old sensation **Always a Rainbow** (Mr. Prospector) worked a half-mile yesterday at Woodbine in :49 2/5, breezing. The Canadian-bred, who is out of Canada's Champion Two and Three-Year-Old Filly Rainbow Connection, took Woodbine's Sept. 25 Cup and Saucer S. on the turf in his last.

BELDAME TO BE NON-BETTING EVENT With only three betting interests set to take part in Saturday's GI Beldame S. at Belmont, New York Racing Association executives have made the race a non-wagering event. In its place on the betting menu, NYRA will add an extra race to the card, which will consist of 11 races. "We thought this was a better way to serve our fans, with an extra race," said NYRA VP Allen Gutterman. "It's not that we were worried about any minus pools. It was a question of, on a day like this, do we want to have a bad betting event?" Trainers Shug McGaughey (**Heavenly Prize** {Seeking The Gold}) and **Educated Risk** {Mr. Prospector}) and Allen Jerkens (**Incinerate** {Groovy}) and **Classy Mirage** {Storm Bird}) both entered two horses in the Beldame. However, there is a strong possibility that Incinerate, who won yesterday's eighth race at Belmont, will be scratched. The only other scheduled starter is the Richard Small-trained **Tennis Lady** (Broad Brush).

CARDMANIA READY FOR COMEBACK Jean Couvercelle's Eclipse Award-winning sprinter **Cardmania** (Cox's Ridge) could make his comeback in the \$100,000-added Ancient Title Breeders' Cup H. October 15 at Santa Anita, trainer Derek Meredith reported yesterday. The eight-year-old gelding suffered a fractured cannon bone last February and hasn't raced since defeating The Wicked North in the Jan. 8 San Carlos H. "He's training super and I think, knock on wood, we're going to make the Ancient Title," said Meredith. Cardmania used last year's Ancient Title as a steppingstone to his victory in the Breeders' Cup Sprint, and Meredith is hoping to follow the same route this year. "We don't want to get ahead of ourselves, but if he runs well, we plan to go to Churchill Downs," the trainer said.

TWINING RETIRED TO WIMBLEDON MGSW Twining (Forty Niner), out of Broodmare of the Year Courtly Dee, has been retired to stand stud at Wimbledon Farm in Lexington, Ky. Bred by Helen Alexander and her mother Helen K. Groves, Twining raced for the mother and daughter team in partnership with Sheikh Mohammed. Twining won five of six starts including the GII Withers S. and GII Peter Pan S. at Belmont for earnings of \$238,140. In his only defeat, he finished second in the GII Dwyer S. to Holy Bull. Twining is owned by a syndicate which will stand the horse for a stud fee of \$10,000 Live Foal.
