### MONTREAL RED TO SKIP BC JUVENILE

**Montreal Red** (D'Accord), the 5-2 morning-line favorite for Saturday's GI Champagne at Belmont and currently the country's leading two-year-old colt, will not be supplemented to the Nov. 5 Breeders' Cup Juvenile at Churchill Downs, according to his trainer Scotty Schulhofer. "Even if he wins the Champagne, he will not go to the Breeders' Cup," said Schulhofer. "Rather than putting up \$120,000 and running over a racetrack he's never been over before, we figure it will be better to give him a rest and wait for Florida. The owners' (Vendome Stables) dream is to have a horse in the Triple Crown."

### SPINSTER NEXT FOR PHONE CHATTER

Herman Sarkowsky's **Phone Chatter** (Phone Trick) will not run in Monday's \$100,000 Lady's Secret H. at Santa Anita, trainer Richard Mandella said yesterday. The Eclipse Award-winning filly will instead be shipped to Kentucky for the GI Spinster S. Oct. 16 at Keeneland. Meanwhile, trainer Warren Stute indicated he plans to run Clement L. Hirsch's GSW **Magical Maiden** (Lord Avie) in the Lady's Secret.

### BREEDERS' CUP PREVIEW DAY NOTES

Three-year-old **Heavenly Prize** (Seeking The Gold), prepping for her first start against older fillies in the GI Beldame, breezed a half-mile at Belmont yesterday in :49.19. "That was exactly what was wanted," said Buzz Tenney, assistant to trainer Shug McGaughey. Stablemate **Lure** (Danzig) is scheduled to blow out for his engagement in the Kelso this morning. Jockey Club Gold Cup hopeful **Colonial Affair** (Pleasant Colony) worked a half-mile in :48.79 yesterday with jockey Jose Santos aboard. "He's doing beautifully," said trainer Scotty Schulhofer. Trainer P.G. Johnson sent both of his Breeders' Cup Preview horses to the Belmont training track for their final tune-ups yesterday. "They both went good," he said. "**A In Sociology** (Ends Well) went three-eighths in :35 3/5 (for the Kelso) and I caught **Kiri's Clown** (Foolish Pleasure) in the same time (for the Turf Classic)." Kelso entrant **Dominant Prospect** (Fortunate Prospect) breezed four furlongs in :47.86 Wednesday, while Gold Cup prospect **Jacksonport** (Vigors) covered a half-mile in :53.02 Thursday.

Trainer Richard Mulhall plans to run both **Supremo** (Gone West) and **Strong Ally** (Tremolino) in the Norfolk. Supremo, second by 1/2-length in the GI Del Mar Futurity in his last, worked five furlongs in 1:00 1/5 yesterday at Santa Anita. Gary Stevens has the mount, while Chris McCarron has been enlisted to ride Strong Ally. Both are owned by The Thoroughbred Corp. and will run as an entry. Other confirmed starters include **Desert Mirage** (Skywalker), Delahoussaye and **Awesome Thought** (Flying Paster), Nakatani. Trainer Mike Mollica was undecided about the status of **Valid Wager** (Valid Appeal) as of Thursday morning. "We'll decide by midnight if we're going to supplement him," said Mollica. Valid Wager was a game second in the Arlington Futurity last out.

**SAYYEDATI OUT OF BREEDERS' CUP**

**Sayyedati** (Shadeed), winner of last year's 1000 Guineas, will not compete in this year's Breeders' Cup and may never race again, according to trainer Clive Brittain. The filly, who won two other Group 1 events, has failed to show her top form this year. "She hasn't done too badly and ran very well to finish second to East Of The Moon in the Jacques Le Marois in August," said Brittain, "but she is being turned out in the afternoons at present and having a complete break for a month. She obviously won't be going to America and a decision on her future is expected next week." Definitely bound for Churchill, however, is Sheikh Mohammed's Irish Champion S. winner **Cezanne** (Ajdal), who will be pointed to the Breeders' Cup Classic.

**DECISION APPEALED BY GULFSTREAM**

Gulfstream Park has appealed the Florida Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering's ruling of Monday, Oct. 3 regarding the takeout dispute between the track and the Florida Thoroughbred Breeders' and Owners Association. Although there is a 30-day period for appeal, Gulfstream President and CEO Douglas Donn instructed David Romanik, the track's general counsel, to file as soon as possible as "the best interests of the Florida thoroughbred industry are served by an expeditious resolution of the matter."

**WILLIAMSTOWN RETIRED TO STUD** Payson Stud President Dean Grimm announced yesterday that Gil Withers S. winner and track-record setting miler **Williamstown** (Seattle Slew) has been retired to stand at Payson Stud in Lexington, Ky. The four-year-old won five of 24 starts, including three stakes, for earnings of \$361,276. The sale of Williamstown was negotiated by Omar Trevino of OTB Bloodstock. The horse is owned by a partnership which will stand him for a stud fee of \$5,000 Live Foal.

Sylvia Heft's **Pulverizing** (Well Decorated), a Maryland-based MSW of \$497,182, has been retired and will be honored with a special ceremony this Saturday at Laurel Race Course. "I'm going to miss having him around," said trainer John "Jerry" Robb. "He's an eight-year-old and age was catching up with him. He did everything. He could go short, long and on the turf. I wish I had a whole barn like him." Pulverizing will be paraded down the track and then be honored with a special plaque in a winner's circle ceremony between races.
