FIVE EUROPEANS TO CONTEST ROTHMANS

A strong European contingent is being prepared for an assault on the Rothmans International at Woodbine next Sunday. British runners will include **River North (IRE)** (Lomond), **Urgent Request (IRE)** (Rainbow Quest) and **White Muzzle (GB)** (Dancing Brave), while France's challenge looks sure to be headed by last year's winner **Husband** (Diesis {GB}) and the Criquelette Head-trained **Petit Loup** (Danzig). White Muzzle, a fast-finishing sixth to Carnegie in last weekend's Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp, will fly out from London's Heathrow Airport Wed., along with the rest of the English team. His trainer Peter Chapple-Hyam said, "Woodbine is a big galloping track nearly a mile round, and it should suit White Muzzle ideally. Even if he wins, though, it will be small consolation for losing the Arc. That was the one race I wanted to win all year."

FLAWLESSLY POSSIBLE FOR LAS PALMAS

Two-time champion **Flawlessly** (Affirmed), who may make her next start in Santa Anita's GII Las Palmas H. October 16, worked six furlongs yesterday in 1:14 4/5 on the turf with jockey Chris McCarron in the saddle. The six-year-old would face **Ask Anita** (Wolf Power {SAf}), and **Corrazona** (El Gran Senor), who beat the champ in the GI Beverly Hills H. at Hollywood. Ask Anita breezed a mile on the turf Friday in 1:42, while Corrazona went the same distance on the main track in 1:41 1/5.

USER FRIENDLY SIDELINED Europe's 1992 Horse of the Year **User Friendly** (Slip Anchor {GB}) suffered a bruised foot during a recent workout and will miss the remainder of the '94 season, according to trainer Rodney Rash. The five-year-old was third in the Live the Dream S. at Del Mar in her most recent start. "We hope to have her ready sometime during the Santa Anita winter meet, and we plan to race her through the end of 1995," said Rash.

Thoro-Graph Analysis by Jerry Brown

When it comes to handicapping two-year-old races, simplistic speed handicapping just does not work--juveniles are developing too quickly. The figure it takes to win a stakes in July has little to do with what wins in October, and early developers are at the mercy of those just coming into their own.

Montreal Red (D'Accord) has run the same Thoro-Graph figure in his last four starts while earning three graded stakes wins. Those figures were good summer two-year-old ratings, but he's not improving.

Sierra Diablo (Conquistador Cielo) and **Wild Escapade** (Wild Again) both ran enormous figures at Saratoga, and if they ran back to those races they would be the ones to beat today. But they bounced in the Futurity; it's clear that they were set back by those big efforts and it seems unlikely they will get back to their best this soon.

The developing horses that should be very strong in the division from here on in, and the ones to beat in this race, are **Timber Country** (Woodman) and **On Target** (Forty Niner). Timber Country has a perfect pattern on the graph--every figure is better than the one before it, and we expect another forward move.

On Target is probably the most interesting one for the long term. He is a half-brother to Sea Cadet, who got considerably better with age, and is trained by Ron McAnally, who doesn't rush his two-year-olds. We'll try a box in the Moet Champagne--Timber Country and On Target. *Thoro-Graph sheets, state-of-the-art performance figures, are used by many industry professionals to evaluate the ability of racehorses.
