BELMONT'S BC PREVIEW DAY A POTPOURRI

Upsets, invaders, a comeback and a coronation marked yesterday's \$2.2 million Breeders' Cup Preview Day at Belmont. Owner William T. Young and trainer D. Wayne Lukas emerged from Breeders' Cup Preview Day with the top two-year-old colt and filly, but lost ground in the Horse of the Year race to Holy Bull when Tabasco Cat came up short in the Jockey Club Gold Cup. The most impressive performance of the day belonged to two-year-old filly sensation Flanders. Unaffected by the controversy surrounding her last week, she handed her three rivals a smashing victory, drawing away by 21 lengths at the wire and prompting her trainer, D. Wayne Lukas, to speculate on how might stack up against colts. "If I could be so bold to say 30 minutes before the (Champagne), I think she's the best of either sex right now." Thirty minutes later, Lukas might not have been as eager to make the comparison when Young and partners' Timber Country delivered him the Champagne trophy as well. The only dampening moment of their day came with Tabasco Cat's fourth-place finish in the Gold Cup. "I felt we were in a position where we needed to win today to sway the (Horse of the Year vote)," said Lukas. "I haven't conceded anything, but that's not my nature. I would like to see Holy Bull make some more of the classics, but if he's Horse of the Year, I'll stand up at the awards dinner and applaud him." The day's heaviest favorite, Lure, was run down in the Kelso by longshot Nijinsky's Gold, but trainer Shug McGaughey was reminded that Lure lost the Kelso two years ago en route to his first Breeders' Cup Mile win. "I can take that," he said. "I'm not going into the Breeders' Cup any less confident." Lure will go for an unprecedented third straight Breeders' Cup Mile win in four weeks at Churchill Downs. In a return to the form that propelled him to his '93 Belmont S. victory, Colonial Affair staged a late move that swept him past the leaders on the turn and brought him home in front by 2 lengths. An upset on the board, the win was no surprise to trainer Scotty Schulhofer. "All week I watched the attention going elsewhere and I kind of chuckled to myself. I knew Colonial Affair was never better and no one was giving us any consideration." Favored Devil His Due sat behind the leaders, made his move on the turn, but was no match for the winner. Tabasco Cat, on his toes in the paddock, was in striking position, but "ran out of gas" in the stretch according to rider Pat Day. West By West was scratched yesterday morning with a bruised foot.

Stumbling at the break, Timber Country recovered in time to make the lead at the first call, surrendering it only briefly down the backstretch, and holding off the late charge of Sierra Diablo. "I instinctively picked him up and slapped him on the shoulder," said jockey Pat Day. "He jumped right into the bridle. I had anticipated being in the middle of the pack, but it turned out that we made most of the running ourselves." The lead position surprised trainer D. Wayne Lukas as well. "That's not his running style," said Lukas. "I think he's a better horse when he comes from off the pace to make one run. His next start will be in the Breeders' Cup." The 9/5 favorite, Montreal Red, was forced to swerve in traffic in the stretch. "I think my horse ran about a mile and an eighth in a mile and a sixteenth race," said rider Jose Santos. Timber Country is a 1/2 to Northern Aspen (Northern Dancer), GISW, \$212,200; to Elle Seule (Exclusive Native), GSW, France; to Mazzacano (Alleged), GSW, England; and to Hamas (Danzig), GISW, Eng..

Unsuccessful in three Group I efforts in Europe, Tikkanen handled both his European and American foes in his first effort in the U.S. West Coast shipper Vaudeville, who won the GI Secretariat this summer, took the lead from Kiri's Clown on the turn and opened up a length at the top of the stretch but was collared by the winner in mid stretch and gave way grudgingly in a fierce stretch duel. "It was very, very heavy (in his last race) in Italy," said winning trainer Jonathan Pease. "The firm ground helped him. I shouldn't think he'll go in the Breeders' Cup. I don't think he's good enough for the Breeders' Cup. He'll no doubt go back to France and stay in training." The 9-5 favorite, Fraise, ran evenly to be fourth. "My horse didn't run at all," said trainer Bill Mott. "There were no excuses for him. I will have to reconsider going to the Breeders' Cup Turf. He is a 1/2 to Turgeon (Caro), MGISW, Ire. & Fr., and Champion Stayer, Ireland; to Greenville (Clever Trick), SW, \$138,887.

Grabbing the lead at the break, Flanders increased her advantage at every point of call. Up by 10 at the top of the stretch, she more than doubled that lead at the wire in a performance Wayne Lukas called the most impressive since "Landaluce's 20 length-win in the Lassie S. at Hollywood." "Unbelievable," said her rider, Pat Day. "She just tip-toed over the racetrack. It was an awesome performance." Owner William T. Young said of the performance, "it was my biggest thrill. She's certainly the best filly we've ever had and maybe the best horse we've ever had."

Heavenly Prize moved to the front of the three-year-old filly class with a powerful performance in the Beldame, declared a non-betting event when the race drew just three wagering interests. "She's won three Grade I stakes, beat Lakeway decisively--if they cut it off right now, I'd be disappointed if she didn't win (the title)," said McGaughey. "She's an exceptional filly." Jockey Pat Day was equally impressed with the win. "She's genuine," said Day. "Shug told me to let her settle back and make one run. She collared them pretty easily." Trainer Allen Jerkens, whose Classy Mirage finished third here, is looking ahead to the Breeders' Cup Distaff with Sky Beauty. "I will be concerned if she goes against Sky Beauty in the Breeders' Cup Distaff," said Jerkens. "But there will be other horses to watch too."

Longshot Jido sprung to an early lead down the backside, but was soon overtaken by Dominant Prospect, who was followed closely by Lure. Around the turn, Lure moved to the front and appeared to be the winner at the eighth pole, but was caught by the late-running Nijinsky's Gold and worn down in a stout drive. The gelding, who had set a world record for 7fT in the Jaipur earlier this summer, is not nominated to the Breeders' Cup and may not be supplemented, according to his connections. Lure, who gave 14 pounds to the winner, "made a good effort at the end, but the other horse had the momentum," said trainer Shug McGaughey. "Maybe the 128 pounds got to him or the course was a tad bit soft. Mike said he was bobbling a little bit over it."

Serena's Song broke sharply, wiring the field by 2 3/4 lengths over CALL NOW (Wild Again) for her 1st trip to the winner's circle since capturing the G2 Landaluce at Hol on Jul. 9th. ROYAL MOUNTAIN INN OUT FOR SEASON

The morning-line favorite in the Turf Classic, **Royal Mountain Inn** (Vigors) was withdrawn from the race with an ankle injury, and will not race again for the rest of this season, according to trainer Barclay Tagg. "He has a little splint bone on his right front ankle that has pulled away from his cannon bone," said Tagg. "There is swelling and it has made him extremely uncomfortable. It's something that's come up progressively this week. Now, it's causing so much irritation there (was) no way he (could) run. We're just sick about it." Tagg said that the ankle would be X-rayed and the 5-year-old gelding prepared for a '95 campaign.

ERHAAB SALE COMPLETED Epsom Derby winner **Erhaab** (Chief's Crown) has been purchased for \$5.5 million and will stand next season at the Agricultural Association East Stud in Hokkaido, Japan. Negotiations concerning the colt have been going on for some time--a Japanese bid was on the table in late August--but the deal, now subject to veterinary tests, was not finalized until Friday. Erhaab joins the two previous Epsom Derby winners, Commander In Chief and Dr Devious, who both now stand in Japan. David Gibson, a spokesman for England's Thoroughbred Breeders' Association, said, "The Japanese are buying these stallions for very high prices and standing them at subsidized fees. We have no chance of competing with that."

TOP ENGLISH TEAM HEADED FOR

KENTUCKY Barathea (Sadler's Wells), runner-up in Ascot's Queen Elizabeth II S. last time out, will miss next weekend's Prix de la Foret at Longchamp and instead will go straight to the Breeders' Cup at Churchill Downs. The Luca Cuman trainee will make a second bid for the Breeders' Cup Mile; he was fifth behind Lure last year. **Distant View** (Mr. Prospector), beaten only a head in the St. James Palace S. and winner of the Sussex S. before finishing fifth in the Queen Elizabeth II, will also be aimed at the Mile. His owner, Khalid Abdullah, will also send Irish Oaks heroine **Bolas** (Unfuwain), and Prix Vermeille second-place finisher **Yenda** (Dancing Brave), third in the Turf Classic at Belmont yesterday, for the Breeders' Cup Turf. The Saudi Arabian Prince could also have a challenger in the Juvenile, if Royal Lodge S. winner **Eltish** (Cox's Ridge) pleases his connections in the GI Dewhurst S. at Newmarket Friday.

ARLINGTON POSTS RECORD HANDLE

Arlington International Racecourse concluded its 1994 season Friday, posting a record \$512,673,341 in total handle for the 131-day meet. The figure represents an 18 percent increase over last year's total of \$433,425,713. "The increase in wagering from out-of-state sources provided a significant boost in our overall handle for the season," said Arlington Chairman Richard L. Duchossois. "But in order to make an accurate comparison to last year, the difference in the takeout from on-track wagering and other sources must be taken into account. While the total amount wagered increased 18 percent, the revenue received by the track for purses and operating expenses showed an increase of only four percent. This is totally reflective of the fact that on-track handle decreased while total handle, particularly out of state, showed dramatic increases." On-track wagering was down three percent, from \$150,471,076 in '93 to \$145,828,057 this year.

Trainer D. Wayne Lukas will send out Vosburgh winner **Harlan** (Storm Cat). "He's a solid horse on a given day, and Sunday they'll have to worry about him," said Lukas. "He's an improving horse and that's the kind you like to have this time of year." The five-year-old, who has never won at six furlongs, will try to give Team Lukas its fourth Boojum winner. Former Lukas assistant Mark Hennig will send out **Demaloot Demashoot** (Bold Ruckus) for his second start off a two-month break; he finished second in the Philadelphia Budweiser Breeders' Cup last out. "He's got a lot of lick and we won't do anything to take him back," said Hennig. "He gets good in the fall. He seems to do better once the weather starts to cool down. When he runs his best race, he's as good as any sprinter in the country, but he tends to be a little in and out." A top effort in the Boojum will earn Demaloot Demashoot a trip to the Breeders' Cup Sprint.

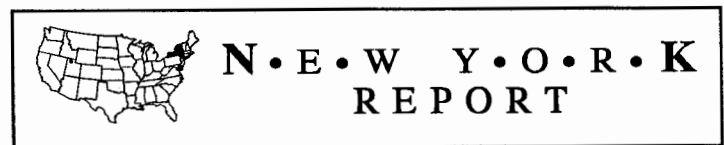
