BREEDERS' CUP PREVIEW WRAP-UP Four of the six stakes winners on Saturday's Breeders' Cup Preview card at Belmont Park will be at Churchill Downs for the main event November 5. **Flanders** (Seeking the Gold), awesome winner of the Frizette, and Moet Champagne hero **Timber Country** (Woodman) will represent Team Lukas in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies and Juvenile, respectively. "I'm still soaking it up," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas yesterday morning after his double Grade I day. "Days like that don't always come around." Lukas will also saddle **Tabasco Cat** (Storm Cat), fourth in the Jockey Club Gold Cup, for the Classic. Trainer Shug McGaughey will send both Beldame winner **Heavenly Prize** (Seeking the Gold) and Kelso runner-up **Lure** (Danzig); Heavenly Prize was third in last year's Juvenile Fillies, while Lure will bid for his third Mile. Both runners came out of their Preview races in good order; McGaughey added that GISW **Dispute** (Danzig), second to Sky Beauty in the Ruffian H. last out, may make the trip to Kentucky for the Distaff as well. Gold Cup victor **Colonial Affair** (Pleasant Colony) will be pointed for the Classic, looking to better his last-place finish of a year ago. "He's never been as good as he is now, and he showed that Saturday," said Sal Russo, assistant to trainer Scotty Schulhofer. Gold Cup runner-up **Devil His Due** (Devil's Bag), eighth in the '93 edition, will be making his final career start in the Classic. **Go for Gin** (Cormorant), a disappointing eighth and last in the Gold Cup, seemed to come out of the race well and may still head to Churchill. "There was no excuse, physically," said trainer Nick Zito. "He scoped beautifully, and the x-rays of his knees and ankles were perfect. We'll take a blood test this week, but the last one we took Sept. 23 was perfect, and I expect this one will be, too. The only thing I can figure out is he didn't have stickers on his shoes, and he came back with an ever-so-slight burn (rundown) from spinning his wheels over the track." As to his Classic status, Zito said, "If everything is okay and he trains the way I expect, we'll go. I think it's safe to say if we go to Churchill Downs, he will not embarrass himself." The connections of Kelso winner **Nijinsky's Gold** (Lot o' Gold) and Turf Classic runner-up **Vaudeville** (Theatrical {Ire}) are still undecided as to plans for the Breeders' Cup.

Making only his third start in this country after winning four GI races and earning a championship in his native country, Brazilian-bred Sandpit followed a win in the Live The Dream S. at Del Mar with his second straight as the 7-5 favorite. Sitting just off pacesetter REGENCY (GB) (Dancing Brave) to the quarter pole, the five-year-old took control on the turn for home and had enough left to turn back second choice Grand Flotilla. "He did everything pretty easy," said jockey Corey Nakatani. "Turning for home, I let him kick on without asking him. When he gets to the front, he relaxes, and I think that's the big key to getting a horse to go this far." Said winning trainer Richard Mandella, "I've asked the Japan Cup people to keep an eye on us and consider us for an invitation. We're not eligible to the Breeders' Cup, so surely we wouldn't want to miss the Japan Cup if we had a chance. If we were eligible to the Breeders' Cup, we'd go. But he's not eligible and neither is his sire, so we'd have to pay 20 percent, and that's a big ticket. You just can't afford to do that." Runner-up Grand Flotilla is Breeders' Cup eligible and trainer Jenine Sahadi indicated that the Turf could be his next start.

PASEANA OUT OF SPINSTER Champion **Paseana** (Ahmad {Arg}) will miss the October 16 **Spinster** at **Keeneland**; trainer **Ron McAnally** reported yesterday that the seven-year-old mare will undergo minor surgery to remedy an entrapped epiglottis and will likely be out for the rest of the year. "At her age, I can't believe this happened to her," said **McAnally**. **Paseana** had not been scheduled to run in the **Breeders' Cup** because her owners were unwilling to pay still another supplementary fee to make her eligible. Although she will be eight next year, **Paseana** may return for a '95 campaign. "She's getting close to the all-time earnings mark for fillies and I know that the **Craigs** want to break the record, so she may be back." **Dance Smartly** is the all-time money earner among fillies and mares with \$3,263,835. **Paseana** has bankrolled \$2,874,212.

JORGE VELASQUEZ RETURNS TO

WINNER'S CIRCLE Hall of Fame jockey **Jorge Velasquez** was back in the winner's circle yesterday for the first time since his return to the saddle Sept. 29 after booting home **Triple Seven** in the fifth race at **Calder**. **Velasquez** missed most of the past eight months after suffering a broken pelvis and hairline fracture of the neck in a training accident at **Calder** Feb. 3. The 47-year-old had attempted a comeback in May, but, still feeling the effects of his injuries, took the additional time to recover.

HATOOF CONFIRMED FOR CHAMPION

STAKES Hatoof (Irish River {Fr}), heroine of the **GI Beverly D S.** at **Arlington**, will bid for her second consecutive **Dubai Champion S.** at **Newmarket** Saturday. Also expected for the **GI** event are **Alderbrook** (Ardross {Ire}) and **Mistle Cat** (Storm Cat), first and fourth in the **Prix Dollar** at **Longchamp**; 2000 **Guineas** runner-up **Grand Lodge** (Chief's Crown), **Sacramento** (Shirley Heights {GB}), fourth last out in the **St. Leger**, and French invader **Dernier Empereur** (Tremolino). **Mistle Cat** will work Tuesday before he is a confirmed starter, but trainer **Sean Woods** said, "He's in good shape and the plan is to run. He lost his off-fore shoe at **Longchamp**, which did not help his chances, and I'd be hopeful of reversing the form with **Alderbrook**." Irish 2000 **Guineas** winner **Turtle Island** (Fairy King) will go in either the **Champion S.** or this week's **Challenger S.**

ELTISH FAVORED FOR DEWHURST Royal Lodge S. winner **Eltish** (Cox's Ridge) heads a field of nine pointing for the prestigious **GI Generous Dewhurst S.** at **Newmarket** Friday. He will face **Al Widyan** (Slip Anchor), **Middle Park S.** winner **Fard** (Reprimand), **Green Perfume** (Naevus), **Juyush** (Silver Hawk), **Korambi** (Kris), **Prix du Salamandre** victor **Pennekamp** (Bering), Royal Lodge runner-up **Stiletto Blade** (Dashing Blade) and **Takkatamm** (Forty Niner).
