SUPREMO SET FOR BREEDERS' CUP GII Norfolk S. winner **Supremo** (Gone West) came out of Sunday's race in good order and will try to move to the head of his division in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile November 5. Commenting on the competition he will meet in the race, trainer Richard Mulhall said, "It's the same horses I've been running with. Timber Country --I beat him a half-length the last time I ran with him (in the Del Mar Futurity). He's a nice horse and I know he improves going around two turns, too. On Target beat us both, but he finished third (in the Moet Champagne). It isn't like there are any big surprises that I can see right now."

FESTIVAL OF THE SUN SATURDAY AT CALDER Calder Race Course in Miami, Florida will hold its 1994 Festival of the Sun this Saturday, October 15. The Festival card will feature six stakes, headed by two \$400,000 divisions of the Florida Stallion Stakes as well as the \$100,000 Miami Beach Sprint H. Sprint entrant **Exclusive Praline** (Ecliptical), winner of this year's GII Ohio Derby and GIII Lafayette S. at Keeneland, worked five furlongs yesterday at Calder in :59 3/5 under jockey Wigberto Ramos. "It was a good move," said trainer Steve Towne. "We're all set now and Ramos will ride him Saturday." Likely to face Exclusive Praline in the Miami Beach are **Daniel's Boy** (Huckster), **Jack Livingston** (Deputy Minister), **K S Fury** (Gulch), **Migrating Moon** (Silver Buck), **Slerp** (Slewpy) and **Swedaus** (Proud Birdie).

MUHTARRAM HEADS TO DUBAI CHAMPION STAKES **Muhtarram** (Alleged), who finished third to Paradise Creek in the GI Arlington Million, may run in blinkers in Saturday's G1 Dubai Champion S. at Newmarket, England. The five-year-old was tried in headgear over the weekend and worked impressively at trainer John Gosden's Newmarket base.

Reserved just off the pace to the top of the lane, Western Echo rallied strongly to take control in midstretch and pull away from the field to win as much the best; it was his second straight stakes win. Said winning trainer Buddy Delp after the race, "We've been high on this horse all along. Looking at the two-year-olds out there, I think he deserves a shot at the Breeders' Cup. He'll run all day. I think he can handle the distance of the Breeders' Cup Juvenile." Added jockey Edgar Prado, who was booting home his third winner of the afternoon, "He broke sharp. I had plenty of horse--then the rail opened up. He did it real easy today." The slight favorite in the field, SW CULINARY DELIGHT (Notebook), showed little while racing wide.

Jockey Eddie Delahoussaye had odds-on choice Hollywood Wildcat in front from the start and the champion filly was never really threatened, turning back the challenge of Exchange in the stretch and cruising under the line by 2 1/4 for her first dirt win since the '93 Breeders' Cup Distaff. "I don't think the race took too much out of her," said trainer Neil Drysdale. "We didn't plan to be in front, but it just came up that way. The pace was slow. If all goes well, we'll probably ship her to Kentucky on the 12th." Said Delahoussaye, "She broke kind of flat-footed and I tapped her on the shoulder and got her running--all of a sudden, I'm on the lead. I knew that we were going slow...I didn't care who came to her, they weren't going to beat her." Runner-up Exchange will also ship to Churchill to take another crack at Hollywood Wildcat in the Distaff.

OBS FALL MIXED SALE RESULTS The first session of the Ocala Breeders' Sales Fall Mixed sale, held yesterday, showed a nearly 27 percent drop in average as 135 horses sold for a total of \$1,217,000, an average of \$9,015. Last year, 133 horses sold on opening day of the sale for a gross of \$1,636,700, an average of \$12,306. The session topper was the nine-year-old mare **Juniper Jupiter**; believed in foal to Valid Appeal, the daughter of Northern Jove--Connie Pat (George Royal) has produced two winners from four foals, including SW Beyond Therapy (Singular). The broodmare, consigned by Cardinal Training Center, went for a bid of \$42,000 to Jerry Wynn. The sale continues through Thursday.
