**VIRGINIA LICENSE AWARDED** The Virginia Racing Commission yesterday voted 4-0, with one abstention, to award a license to Arnold Stansley, President of Raceway Park in Toledo, Ohio, to operate a thoroughbred and harness facility in New Kent County, Virginia. Located 22 miles east of Richmond, the county had just over 10,000 residents in the 1990 census. Joe DeFrancis, owner and operator of Laurel and Pimlico Racecourse, will manage the \$40-million, 6,000-seat Colonial Downs, which will operate a 102-meet during the summer. Maryland tracks will be closed during the Colonial meet.

**TATTERSALLS YEARLING SALE BEGINS** Tattersalls Ltd.'s five-day yearling sale at Newmarket, England opened Monday. There were 72 yearlings averaging 7,862 guineas sold in the sale's first session, while the second session saw 205 horses sold for an average of 9,642 guineas. Top price through the first two sessions was paid for a bay colt by Mtoto--Lightning Legacy (Super Concorde). The colt, a half-brother to GII winner Black Monday (GB) (Busted {GB}), was consigned to the sale by Childwick Bury Stud and purchased for 56,000 guineas by Shadwell Estate Company Ltd.

**SOUTHERN TRUCE RETIRED** Southern Truce (Truce Maker), a Cinderella mare who rose from the claiming ranks to become a multiple Grade I winner, has been retired, trainer Roger Stein said Wednesday morning. "She'll serve as a broodmare in Kentucky," said Stein of the six-year-old California-bred. Robert and Janice McNair, owners of Rose Hill Stable, bought Southern Truce from Vic and Peggy Johnson's Regal Rose Stable for a reported \$300,000 early this year. Stein had claimed Southern Truce for Regal Rose for \$16,000 early in 1991. She went on to earn \$884,888. "She'll be sorely missed," Stein continued. "It just won't be the same without her."

Trainer King T. Leatherbury claimed morning-line favorite **Taking Risks** (Two Punch) late last year for \$20,000. In 11 races since the claim, the four-year-old gelding has earned \$487,980. "At the time it was just a routine claim," said Leatherbury. "He was still eligible for a "non-winners of one" allowance race, so naturally we ran him there first. Then we went in a non-winners of two, then three, then four, and then he went on and won a Maryland-bred stake, then an open stakes race. After that he was second in a Grade II race in Kentucky, then he won a Grade III race at Laurel and then he won the Iselin. It's funny, once a horse gets good, everyone says, 'Claim me one like that.' But if I could tell the good ones from the bad ones, I wouldn't have any bad ones."

 A field of seven or eight is shaping up, comprised of stakes-winners **Dispute** (Danzig), **Let's Be Alert** (Gold Alert), **Miss Dominique** (Private Account), **One Dreamer** (Relaunch), **Passing Vice** (Vice Regent), **Pennyhill Park** (Ascot Knight), **Phone Chatter** (Phone Trick) and **Twice the Vice** (Vice Regent). Trainer Tom Proctor said he will look at the weather forecast Friday and, if rain is predicted, he might enter One Dreamer. The six-year-old mare worked five furlongs in 1:01 Wed. at Keeneland. Phone Chatter arrived at Keeneland Tues. from California. "She breezed a mile in :38 Saturday at Santa Anita," said Gary Mandella, son and assistant to trainer Richard Mandella. **WASHINGTON D.C. INT'L-GI, \$600,000, 3yo/up, 1 1/4mT**

Prince Fahd Salman's **Zoman** (Affirmed), who took the 1992 running of the Washington D.C. Int'l, arrived at Laurel yesterday morning from England. The seven-year-old was brought back into training after encountering fertility problems at stud. Zoman returned to the races Oct. 2 with a close sixth-place finish in the G2 Prix du Rond-Point at Longchamp. Bill Mott trainee **Paradise Creek** (Irish River {FR}) is expected to arrive at Laurel Friday. The five-year-old, who will be ridden by regular jockey Pat Day, is not scheduled for any serious workouts this week and will gallop up to the race. Also pointing to the event are Maryland-based runners **Redcall** (Acallade) and **Maryland Moon** (Al Mamoon), New York-based **Binary Light** (Bionic Light), English-based **Beneficial** (GB) (Top Ville {IRE}) and French-based **Marildo** (FR) (Romildo {GB}).

**Saturday, Santa Anita:**

**GOODWOOD H.-GII, \$200,000a, 3yo/up, 9f**

William J. Zellerbach's **Lykatill Hil** (Pilgrim) worked five furlongs in 1:01 1/5 Tues. at Santa Anita in preparation for the Goodwood. Eddie Delahoussaye was up for assistant trainer Alan Sherman. "He's never raced at Santa Anita, but he seemed to handle the track okay," said Sherman of Lykatill Hil. The Northern California-based runner comes off a successful Del Mar campaign in which he took the Windy Sands H. and the Del Mar Budweiser BC. Molson Million winner **Dramatic Gold** (Slew o' Gold) drilled five furlongs in 1:00 3/5 handily Wed. Trainer Jenine Sahadi said **Fastness** (IRE) (Rousillon) is "50-50" to run in the race. Other confirmed starters include **Bertrando** (Skywalker), **Del Mar Dennis** (Dixieland Band) and **Stuka** (Jade Hunter).

**E.P. TAYLOR S.-GII, \$300,000a, 3yo/up, f/m, 10fT**

Last year's E.P. Taylor heroine **Hero's Love** (Hero's Honor) breezed five furlongs yesterday over Woodbine's training track in a leisurely 1:05; stablemate **Mysteriously** (Afleet) covered the same distance in 1:00 1/5. Trainer Roger Attfield is scheduled to send out **Hey Hazel** (Ascot Knight), winner of the recent Arlington Matron H. in Chicago, and Canadian Oaks champion **Plenty Of Sugar** (Ascot Knight). Another contender is **Myrtle Irene** (Commemorate), who worked brilliantly under Sandy Hawley over Woodbine's firm turf course yesterday, going 7 furlongs in 1:23 2/5 and pulling up in 1:34 4/5 for the mile. Also pointing to the race are **Bold Ruritana** (Bold Ruckus), **Show Special** (Smarten), **Ballerina Queen** (Kris S.), **Starry Val** (Val de l'Orne {FR}), **Truly A Dream** (IRE) (Darshaan {GB}), **Dahlia's Dreamer** (Theatrical {IRE}) and **Silky Feather** (Personal Flag).
