CHICK LANG JR. DIES Chick Lang Jr., who resigned as the general manager of Retama Park in San Antonio, Texas in September due to failing health, died of cancer yesterday morning. He was 47. Lang had previously served as administrative director of Oaklawn Park and as director of public relations and simulcasting at the Birmingham Turf Club. He also represented jockey Julie Krone as an apprentice rider in Maryland. Lang's family has been involved in horse racing for five generations. He is survived by his wife, Kimberly, both parents, and a sister. At his request, no memorial service will be held. The Lang family has requested that in lieu of flowers, donations be made to the Oaklawn Backstretch Ministry or the Ouachita Children's Center in Hot Springs, where Lang was named Volunteer of the Year in 1991.

SARDULA TO PASS BREEDERS' CUP SPRINT Sardula (Storm Cat), will not make her next scheduled start in the Nov. 5 Breeders' Cup Sprint, trainer Brian Mayberry revealed at his Santa Anita barn yesterday morning. Mayberry declined to elaborate on why the three-year-old filly would not be sent to Churchill.

OBS FALL MIXED SALE CONCLUDES The fourth and final session of the Ocala Breeders' Sales Company's 1994 Fall Mixed Sale took place yesterday. The session's highest price of \$21,000 was brought by **Axe A.J.**, a seven-year-old stakes-placed mare by Foyt--Second Winter (The Axe II), in foal to Prospector's Gamble. Consigned to the sale by Hart Farm, agent for the dispersal of Jan, Mace and Samantha Siegel, Axe A.J. was purchased by Wesley Ward. Through the sale's four sessions, 686 horses were sold for a total of \$4,010,400 and an average of \$5,846, down 13 percent from last year's average of \$6,722.

MAMSELLE BEBETTE RETIRED Big Train

Farms **Mamselle Bebette** (Copelan), winner of four stakes races at Santa Anita's '93-'94 winter/spring meeting, has been retired and will serve as a broodmare at Cedar Point Farm in Paris, Ky., according to owner John Forsythe. Unraced since finishing second to Soviet Problem in a match race at Del Mar Aug. 21, Mamselle Bebette won the Gill La Brea S., Monrovia H., Gill Las Flores Breeders' Cup H., Gill Las Cienegas Breeders' Cup H. and Gill Monrovia H. The Florida-bred mare retires with seven wins from 20 starts and earnings of \$431,175.

A BREAK FOR BELMONT BETTORS In a change designed to provide more equitable returns on wagers and to stimulate some betting pools, a new method of calculating breakage will go into effect at Belmont Park Sunday. Breakage will now be determined by the \$2.00 payoff rather than the bet type as follows: a \$2 payoff of \$2.10 to \$9.90 will be rounded down to 0.00, a payoff of \$10.00 to \$49.99 will be rounded down to 0.20, a payoff of \$50.00 to \$499.99 will be rounded down to 0.50 and a payoff of \$500.00 and up will be rounded down to 1.00. "The system is all set to go and has been checked out by the State," said Clem Imperato, VP, mutuels.
