WARREN CROLL NAMED TOBA "OWNER OF THE MONTH" Warren Croll, owner and trainer of likely Eclipse Award-winner Holy Bull, has been named the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association's "Owner of the Month" for September. The 74-year-old Hall of Famer did not become an owner until long-time client Rachel Carpenter passed away last year and willed Holy Bull to him. Croll sent out his stable star to win the GI Woodward S. last month, putting the colt at the top of the three-year-old class and giving him a leg up on Horse of the Year honors.

BREEDERS' CUP INFO ON INTERNET Beginning October 25, University of Louisville students will be working in the Churchill Downs press box, making information about the November 5 Breeders' Cup available to the more than 25 million Internet users around the world. Internet is an interactive, on-line computer service. The students will input the backstretch notes daily; through a partnership with IgLou, the Internet Gateway of Louisville, the students' reports will be available on the World Wide Web. The service will also offer full-color, full-motion video of workouts throughout Breeders' Cup week. The information is free to anyone with access to Internet; the uniform resource locator to access the service is http://iglou.com/breeders_cup.html.

BRUNSWICK SCRATCHED FROM MEADOWLANDS CUP Brunswick (Private Account) was scratched from last night's GI Meadowlands Cup after developing a cough and a fever. "It's a tough situation," said trainer Tony Margotta. "I don't know where we'll go next with him." The five-year-old GISW, winner of two of his three starts this year, was eighth in the GI Woodward S. in his latest effort.
