## MEADOWLANDS SETS HANDLE RECORD

Total handle on the GI Meadowlands Cup card Friday night at the Jersey course established a new record as the track topped the \$5 million mark for the first time. A total of \$5,025,645 was wagered, besting the old mark of \$4,939,829 set on Hambletonian Day during the '94 harness meet. The previous record for a Meadowlands Thoroughbred card was \$4,242,305 handled on the day that Alysheba won the 1988 Meadowlands Cup. The '94 on-track attendance of 14,472 was the largest since 1991.

## DUNLOP TAKES OVER SCOTT STRING

Ed Dunlop, the 25-year-old former assistant to trainer Alex Scott, has been named as successor to the late trainer at Sheikh Maktoum al Maktoum's Oak Stables in Newmarket. The son of trainer John Dunlop, Ed Dunlop has been in charge at the 90-horse yard since Scott was found shot dead two weeks ago. Said Joe Mercer, the former champion jockey who is now racing manager to Sheikh Maktoum, "Sheikh Maktoum will have just the same number of horses in training at the yard as he has done this year." The man accused of Scott's murder, William 'Clem' O'Brien, is in police custody awaiting trial. There has been no application for bail for the 58-year-old groom.

## TATTERSALLS' OCTOBER SALE SHOWS A

**DROP** A total of 829 yearlings were sold for a gross of 10,097,350 guineas during the Tattersalls October Yearling Sales which ended Friday, down from the 10,101,181 guineas paid for 732 lots last year. The average of 12,180 guineas was down nearly 12 percent from 1993. The two sales toppers, attracting bids of 115,000 guineas each, were a colt by Danehill-I Want My Say (Tilt Up), sold by Ireland's Islanmore Stud to John Ferguson Bloodstock; and a filly by Sadler's Wells--Miranisa (Habitat), sold by Ireland's Glenvale Stud to Peter Doyle Bloodstock. "Despite achieving the highest price at the October Yearling Sales for three years, the overall market has proved to be unforgiving," said Tattersalls Chairman Edmond Mahony. "After the successes of last year, the Yearling Sales have perhaps not lived up to expectations, but have accurately reflected the state of the economy throughout Europe."

Hatoof and Grand Lodge shared the lead the first six furlongs, then Grand Lodge took over and looked the likely winner until a group of horses came to challenge. Inside the final 100 yards, Dernier Empereur produced a strong finish to get up on the line. The colt needs only to recover quickly from his exertions to get the go-ahead for a raid on the Breeders' Cup. Said trainer Andre Fabre, "I need to talk things over with owner Gary Tanaka before making a final decision, but assuming the horse comes out of today well enough, the Breeders' Cup is a strong possibility. He would run in either the Classic or the Turf." Jockey Walter Swinburn blamed the slow early pace for the defeat of heavy favorite Hatoof. The mare, who normally makes a late run, found herself on the lead for the first quarter mile; despite her fifth-place finish, she will still be pointed to the Breeders' Cup next month.

Today, he felt no different than the horse I rode last year." Added owner Ed Nahem, "Everyone had this horse all but dead and buried. It's nice to be vindicated. We'll think very hard about the Breeders' Cup."
