SEA HERO RETIRED The 1993 Kentucky Derby winner **Sea Hero** (Polish Navy), fifth in Saturday's GII Fayette S. at Keeneland, has been retired and will stand the 1995 season at Lane's End Farm in Versailles, Kentucky. A winner of six races and \$2,929,869, the four-year-old earned his last victory in a seven-furlong allowance at Belmont in May. Said trainer Mack. Miller, "He had no problem Saturday; he's beautifully sound and I thought surely he would run very well, but he didn't. I have no idea what went wrong this year. If he was unsound, I would have some excuses. If I had to do it over again, I would not have kept him on the grass as long as I did because the major races he won were all on the dirt."

TOTAL HANDLE, ATTENDANCE UP AT BELMONT FALL MEET The daily average for both total handle and on-track attendance showed gains at the 39-day Belmont Park fall meeting which concluded yesterday. Total wagering for the meet averaged \$7,474,561, up 6.2 percent over numbers for last year's 41-day season. The average on-track attendance of 9,490 rose slightly, up 2.3 percent over the 1993 average of 9,282. On-track handle showed a decrease of 3 percent, averaging \$2,287,885 a day for the '94 meet. The nation's leading rider, Mike Smith, topped the jockey standings with 39 victories; Smith also tied his record for number of stakes wins in a year during the meet, notching stakes number 62 aboard Itaka in the Empire Classic H. at Belmont Saturday. Hall of Famer Allen Jerkens, who saddled two winners on Sunday's card, led the trainers with 17 victories.

Champion Phone Chatter was in touch with the leaders early but dropped back on the turn for home and finished last. "Halfway around the turn she didn't feel like herself, and we come back to find out that she ran down through her bandages," said jockey Corey Nakatani. "I know she's better than this."
