AQUEDUCT OPENS TODAY New York racing switches to Aqueduct today for a 66-day meet, featuring the return of the \$250,000 NYRA Mile. The Grade I event highlights the Big A's Holidayfest card November 26. Also scheduled for that day are the GII \$200,000 Remsen for two-year-olds, won last year by Derby winner Go for Gin, and the GII \$200,000 Demoiselle for two-year-old fillies, both at a mile and an eighth. A total of 30 stakes, 21 of them graded, will be run during the meet, with racing Tuesday through Sunday to the end of the year.

SEA EMPEROR TO BREEDERS' CUP Sea Emperor (Naked Sky), winner of Saturday's In Reality S., the final leg of the Florida Stallion Series, could make his next start in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile--if there's space for him in the starting gate. "I'm planning on sending him," said trainer Manny Tortora. "But he doesn't have any (Breeders' Cup) points, so it's a question of whether we could get in. I'd like to see him run, though." The two-year-old has been on the board in all seven career starts, but has yet to win a graded stakes.

NAEVUS TO TEXAS Naevus (Mr. Prospector), the sire of earners of better than \$7 million, is moving to Texas and will stand the 1995 season at McDermott Ranch in Waller. The stallion, who previously stood at Airdrie Stud in Kentucky, will still be owned by the syndicate headed by Brereton C. Jones.

DISTANT VIEW TO RACE AT FOUR Distant View (Mr. Prospector), winner of the GI Sussex S. at Goodwood in July, will stay in training next year. The colt is set to race just once more as a three-year-old, heading the powerful Khalid Abdullah team at next month's Breeders' Cup. "He is doing well and being aimed at the Mile," said trainer Henry Cecil, who will also saddle **Eltish** (Cox's Ridge) for the Breeders' Cup Juvenile.

Trainer Christophe Clement sends out the entry of **Statuette** (Pancho Villa), and **Cox Orange** (Tremolino), who finished second and third in the GII Noble Damsel H. at Belmont in September. Cox Orange, who owns a perfect one-for-one record at Aqueduct after taking the Beaugay H. in her seasonal debut back in April, has not started since the Noble Damsel, but Statuette came back to finish fourth in the GII Violet H. at the Meadowlands. "She broke good but lacked racing luck," said Clement of that race. "She always tries hard." The conditioner added that Cox Orange will be retired to the breeding shed at the end of the season. **Jade Flush** (Jade Hunter) tried turf for the first time in the GII Rare Perfume H. last time out and went wire-to-wire to win by 6 1/2. She faces older stakes fillies for the first time.
